





TRIP PLANNING CYCLE

- » Typical visitors began planning their trip 62 days in advance
- » 73% of visitors started planning their trip a month or more in advance of their trip
- Typical visitors booked their accommodations53 days in advance
- » 54% of visitors have a booking window of less than 3 months

Booked Accommodations/Made Trip Decisions








ONLINE TRIP PLANNING SOURCES*

- » Over 3 in 4 visitors used one or more online resources to help them plan their trip in Maine
- » 3 in 10 visitors used an online travel agency or online search engine, such as Google, to help them plan their trip in Maine
- » 22% of visitors used VisitMaine.com



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


OTHER TRIP PLANNING SOURCES*

» 3 in 10 visitors relied on advice from their friends and family to help them plan their trip in Maine

» Nearly 1 in 5 visitors used travel guides/brochures to help plan their trip in Maine

» 39% of visitors did not use any other resources to help them plan their trip in Maine








REASONS FOR VISITING*

- » 2 in 5 visitors came to Maine to visit friends and relatives
- » Nearly 2 in 5 visitors came to Maine for sightseeing/touring







TV SHOWS & FILM*

» 2% of visitors said a TV show or film inspired their trip to Maine

» All of the visitors who were inspired by a TV show or film said it made them think about Maine as a place to visit

» 6% of visitors who were NOT inspired by a TV show or film to visit Maine said they visited the location of a TV show or film while in Maine Base: 10% of visitors who were inspired by a TV show or film



OTHER STATES & PROVINCES CONSIDERED*

- » 66% visitors considered visiting ONLY Maine while planning their trips
- » Visitors continued to be more likely to consider visiting nearby U.S. states rather than visiting Canadian provinces








PRE-TRIP RECALL OF ADVERTISING*

- » 2 in 5 visitors recalled advertising or promotions for Maine prior to their trip
- » Visitors who recalled this advertising primarily saw it on social media or the internet
- » This information influenced 26% of all visitors to visit Maine















TRAVEL PARTIES

- » Typical visitors traveled to Maine in parties of 2.3 people
- » Over 2 in 5 visitors traveled as a couple
- » About 1 in 4 traveled alone or as a family
- » 14% of visitors traveled with one or more children in their travel party

Children in Travel Party*








GENDER

» Over half of visitors to Maine interviewed were females








AGE

» The average age of visitors to Maine is 46 years old








RACE & ETHNICITY

» Over 9 in 10 visitors to Maine were white








EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT

» Over 7 in 10 visitors have a college/technical school degree or higher








MARITAL STATUS

» Over 7 in 10 visitors to Maine were married or living with their partner








EMPLOYMENT STATUS

- » The average household income of visitors to Maine is \$100,000 per year
- » 33% of visitors to Maine earned more than \$150,000 per year








NEW & RETURNING VISITORS

- » 17% of visitors were traveling in Maine for the first time
- » Aroostook County has high repeat and loyal visitors, as 36% had previously traveled in Maine more than 10 times






MODES OF TRANSPORTATION

» Most visitors who flew to Maine arrived at Boston Logan International Airport








NIGHTS STAYED

» 93% of visitors stayed one or more nights in Maine on their trip

- » Typical visitors stayed 6.1* nights in Maine on their trips
- » Typical visitors staying overnight in paid accommodations stayed 5.6 nights in Maine on their trips



» Over 2 in 5 visitors who stayed in paid accommodations during their trip booked their lodging through and online travel agency








IN-MARKET VISITOR RESOURCES*

- » 27% of visitors used hotel/resort websites/apps
- » 19% of visitors did not use any resources to plan activities while they were in-market








VISITOR ACTIVITIES*

» Nearly 3 in 5 visitors participated in food/beverage/culinary activities during their trip to Maine


- » 51% of visitors engaged in touring and sightseeing
- » Over 2 in 5 visitors went shopping on their trip to Maine
















LODGING AMENITIES*

An amenity, e.g., food, resort fee, recreation fee, parking, etc., was included in the room price for 7 in 10 visitors

» Price for accommodations included parking for over 7 in 10 visitors

» Food was included in accommodations' pricing for nearly 3 in 10 visitors








OTHER STATES & PROVINCES VISITED*

- » Nearly 2 in 3 visitors did not visit any other U.S. state or Canadian province during their trip
- » Visitors continued to be more likely to visit U.S. states near Maine than they were to visit a Canadian province during their trip








TRAVELING WITHIN MAINE*

» Over 2 in 5 visitors stayed within the region of their primary destination during their trip in Maine, rather than traveling throughout the state


» About 1 in 3 visitors visited the Maine Highlands and Downeast & Acadia in addition to their primary destination within Maine




RECOMMENDING MAINE & ITS REGIONS


» 94% of visitors would recommend that their friends and family choose Maine as their destination for a future visit or vacation

Likelihood of Recommending Region Visited








LIKELIHOOD OF RETURNING TO MAINE

» 98% of visitors will return to Maine for a future visit or vacation



*2% of all visitors are not sure or will probably not return to Maine for the following reasons:

1. Once is enough to see and do everything 2. Quality of accommodations 3. Airline service is too limited/too expensive 4. Lack of activities/attractions 5. Lack of nightlife.






SATISFACTION

» 98% of visitors were satisfied with their trip to Maine


» Over 2 in 3 visitors were very satisfied with their trip to Maine







TRIP RATINGS








OVERCROWDING

METHODOLOGY



Visitor Tracking

96 interviews were completed with visitors to the Aroostook County online and in-person at local attractions, parks, hotels, visitor centers, Service Plazas, shops, downtown areas and events between September 1st, 2023 and November 30th, 2023.
