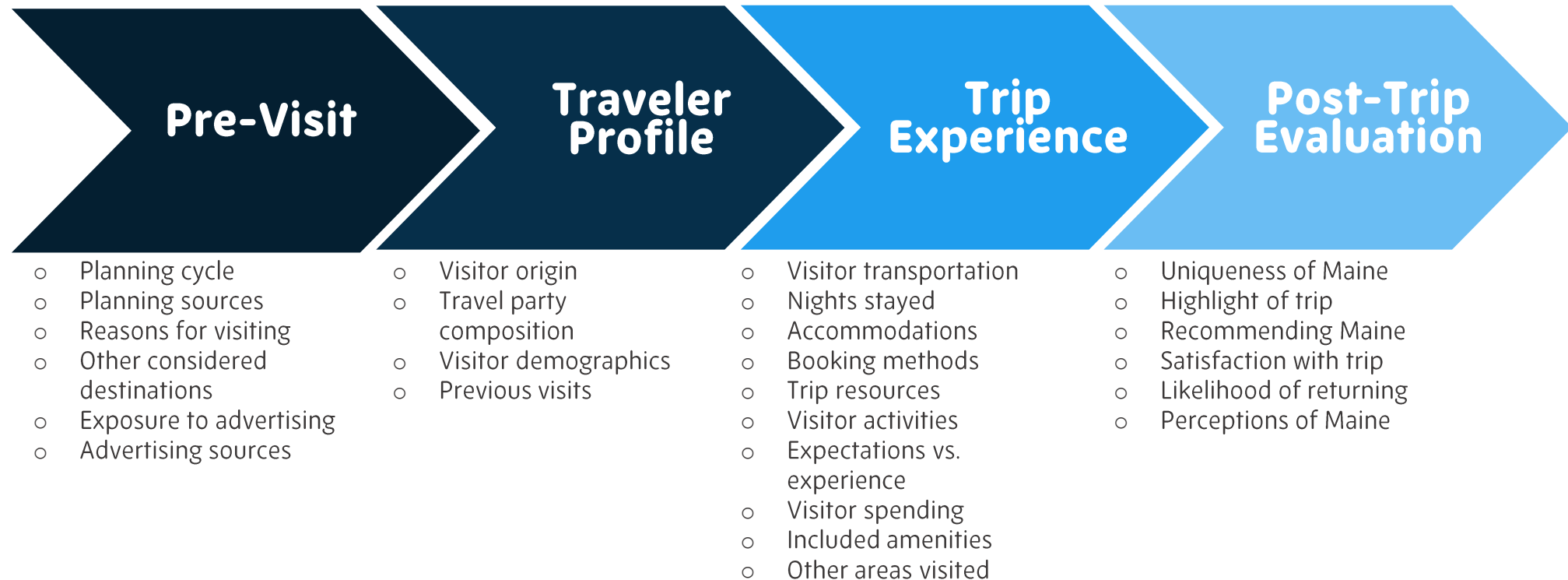


STUDY OBJECTIVES: VISITOR JOURNEY

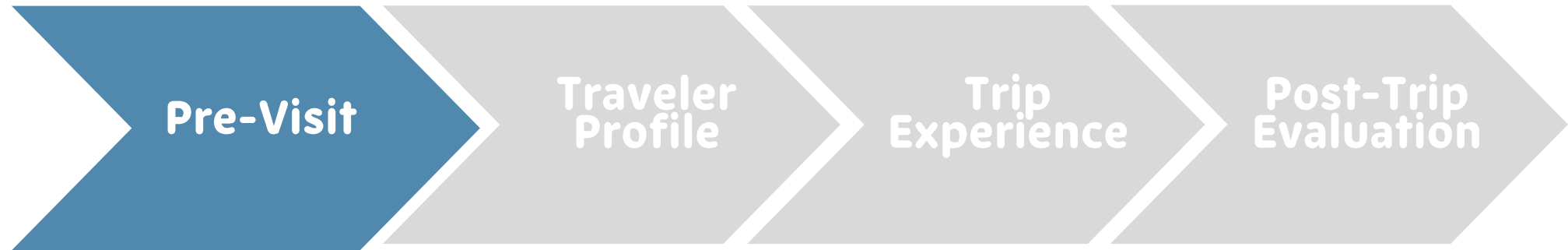
This report presents information about visitors to Maine from May to August 2023.

In the report, we follow the visitors in their journeys.

Along the way, we examine profiles of visitors, their experiences in our destination, and how they evaluate experiences in Maine.



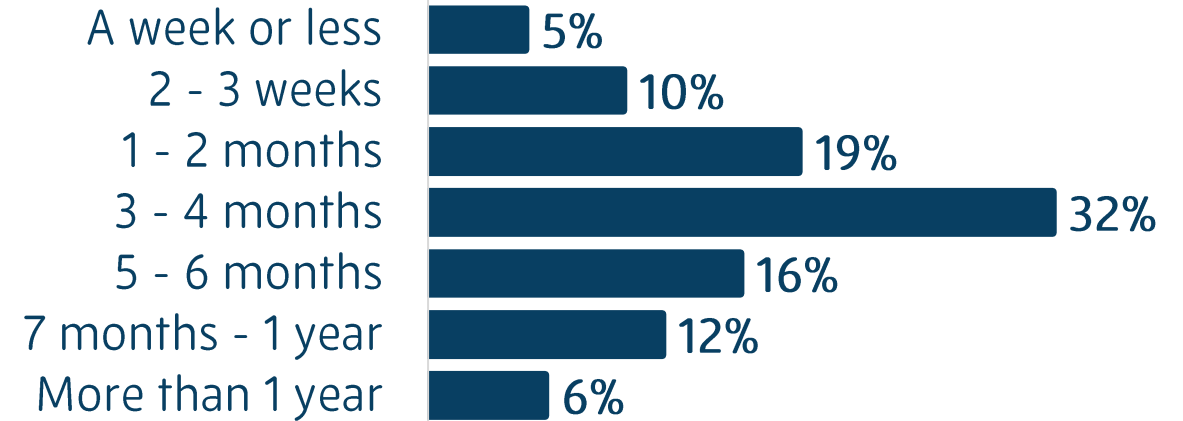
VISITOR JOURNEY: PRE-VISIT



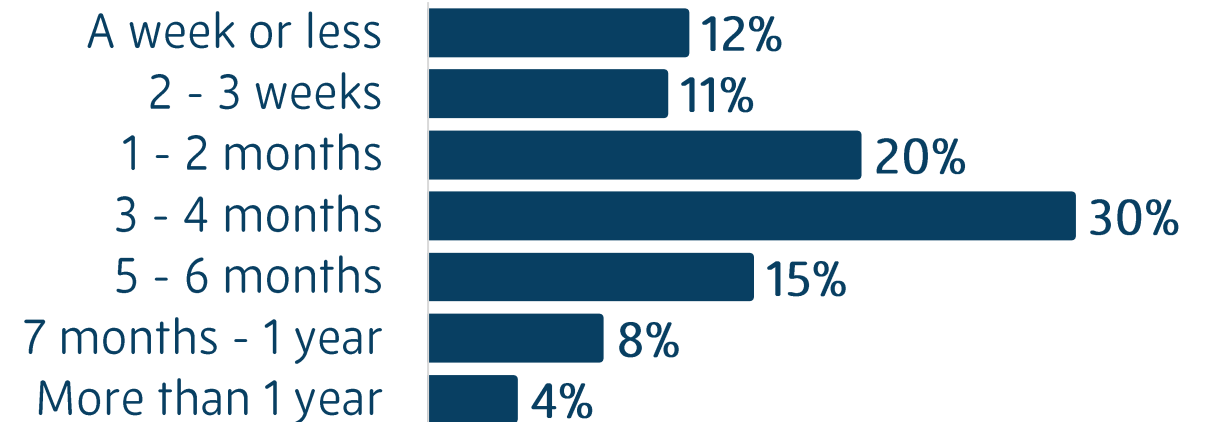
TRIP PLANNING CYCLE

- » Typical visitors began planning their trip **75 days** in advance
- » **85%** of visitors started planning their trip a month or more in advance of their trip
- » Typical visitors booked their accommodations **67 days** in advance
- » **43%** of visitors have a booking window of less than 3 months

Beginning of Trip Planning Cycle

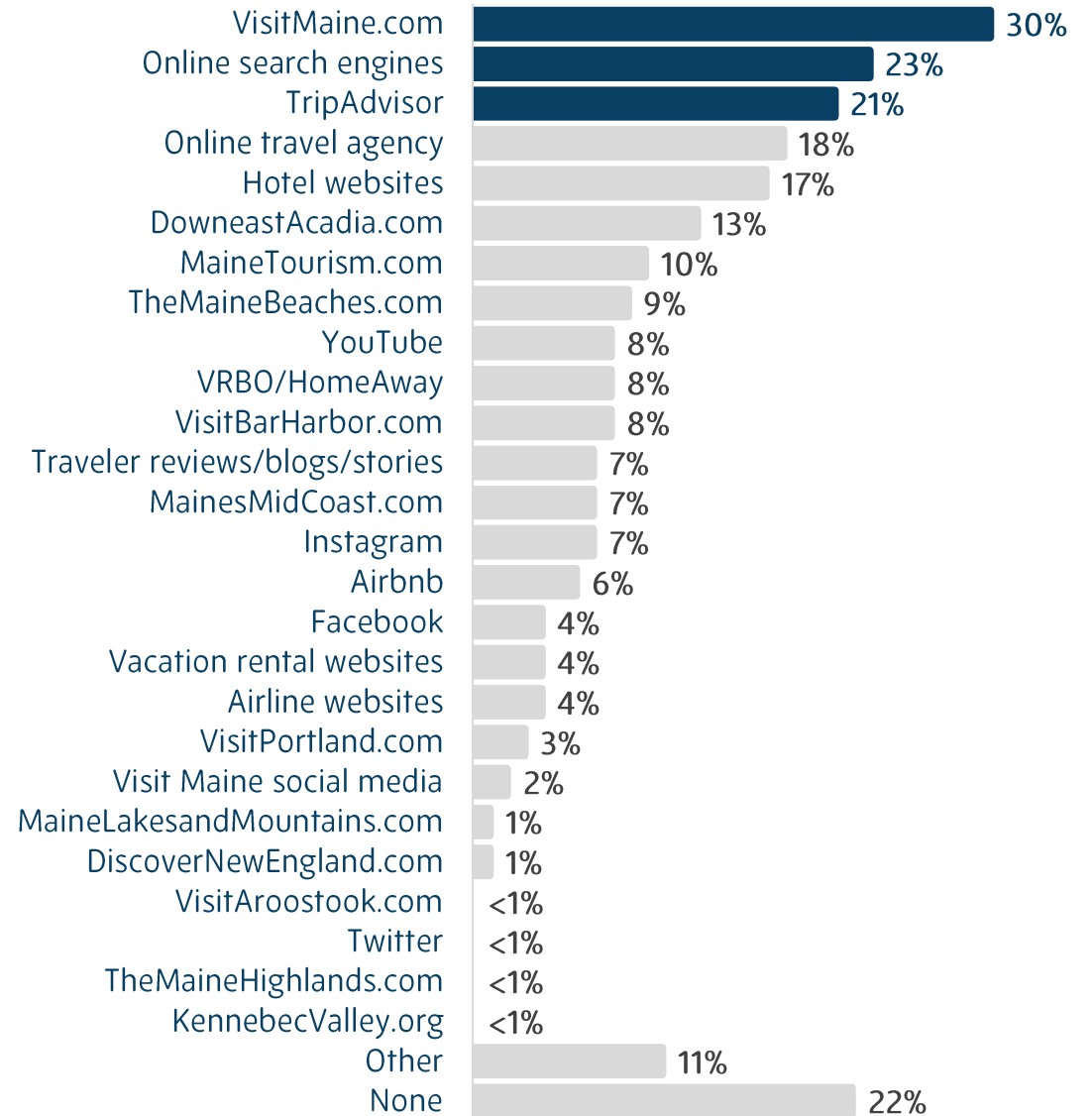


Booked Accommodations/Made Trip Decisions



ONLINE TRIP PLANNING SOURCES*

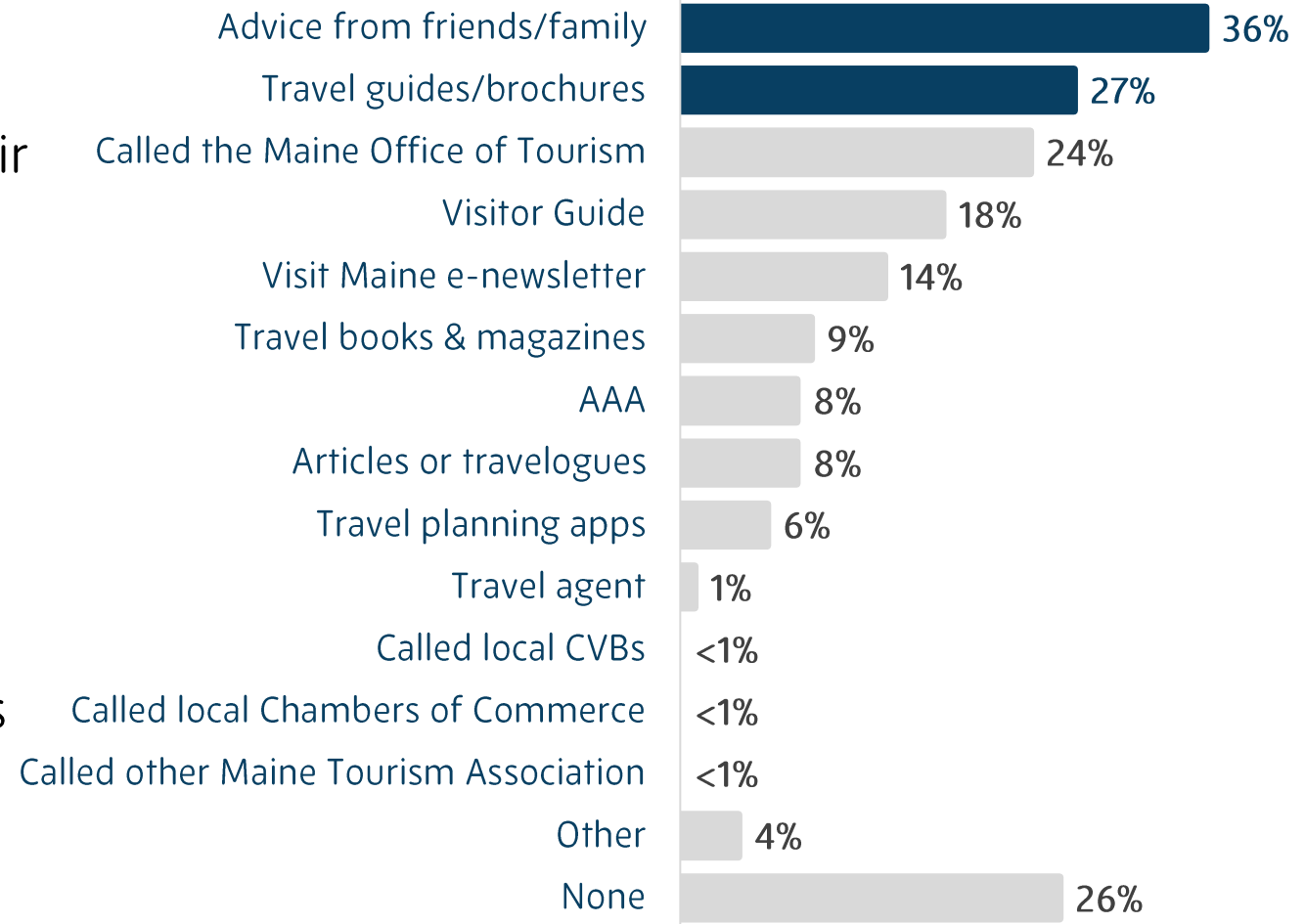
- » Nearly **4 in 5** visitors used one or more online resources to help them plan their trip in Maine
- » **3 in 10** visitors used VisitMaine.com
- » Over **1 in 5** visitors used an online search engine, such as Google, or TripAdvisor to help them plan their trip in Maine

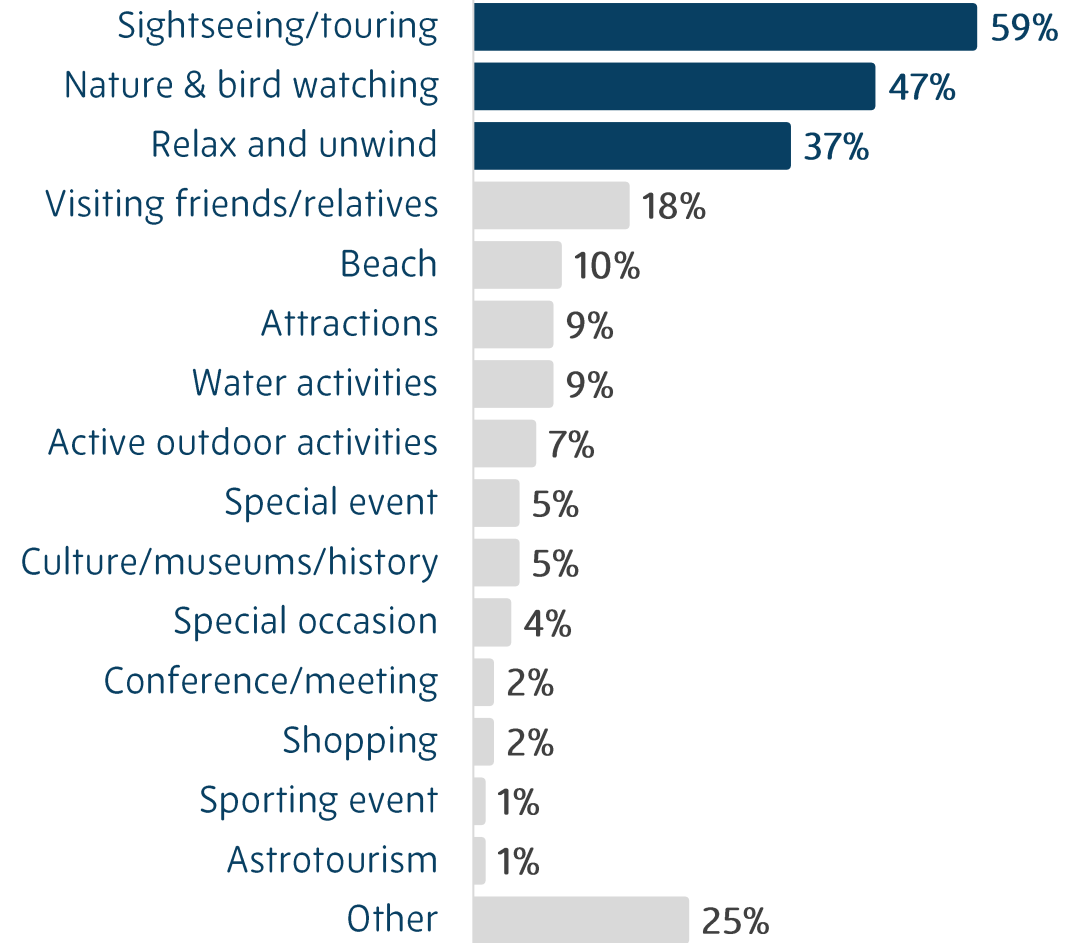
OTHER TRIP PLANNING SOURCES*

- » Nearly **2 in 5** visitors relied on advice from their friends and family to help them plan their trip in Maine
- » Over **1 in 4** visitors used travel guides/brochures to help plan their trip in Maine
- » **26%** of visitors did not use any other resources to help them plan their trip in Maine



REASONS FOR VISITING*

- » Nearly **3 in 5** visitors came to Maine for sightseeing/touring
- » Nearly **half** of visitors came to Maine for nature & bird watching
- » Nearly **2 in 5** visitors came to Maine to relax & unwind



TV SHOWS & FILM*

- » 4% of visitors said a TV show or film inspired their tip to Maine
- » 63% of visitors who were inspired by a TV show or film said it made them think about Maine as a place to visit
- » 3% of visitors who were NOT inspired by a TV show or film to visit Maine said they visited the location of a TV show or film while in Maine

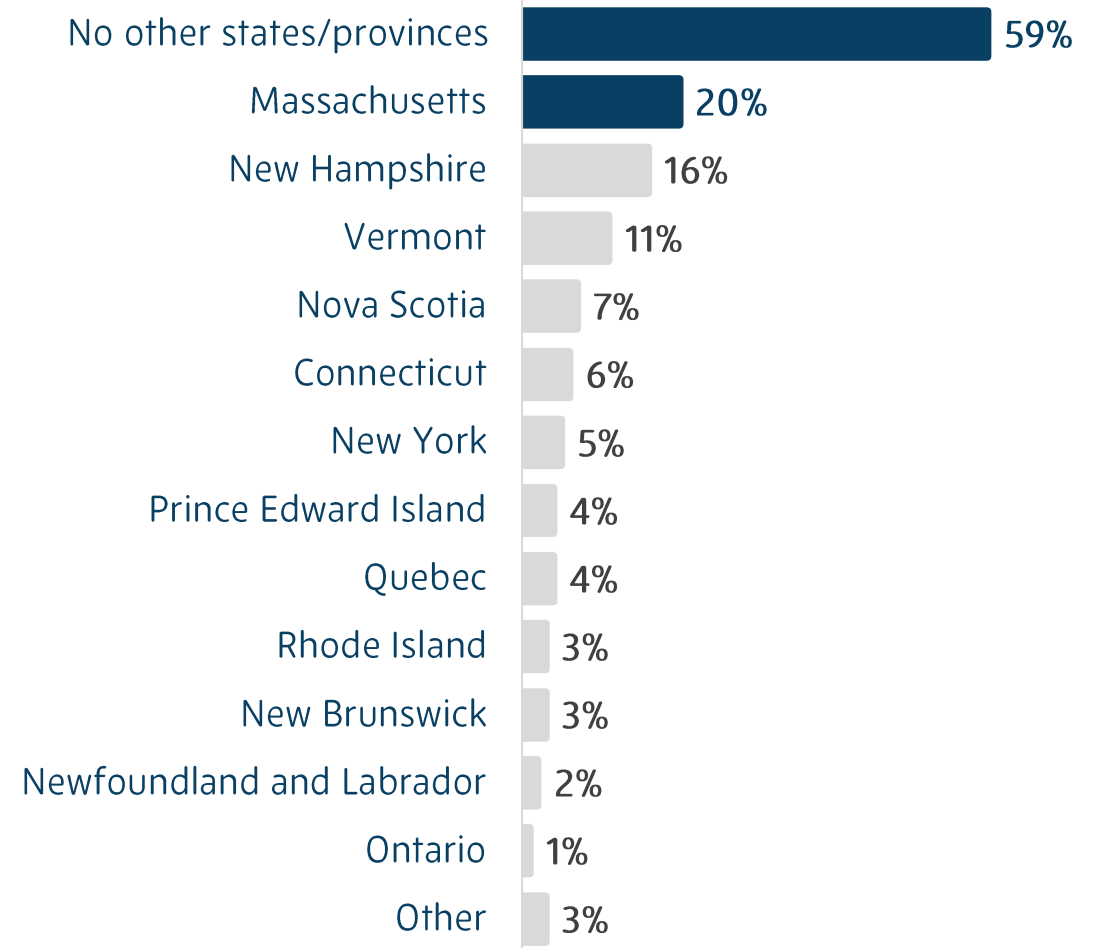

OTHER STATES & PROVINCES CONSIDERED*

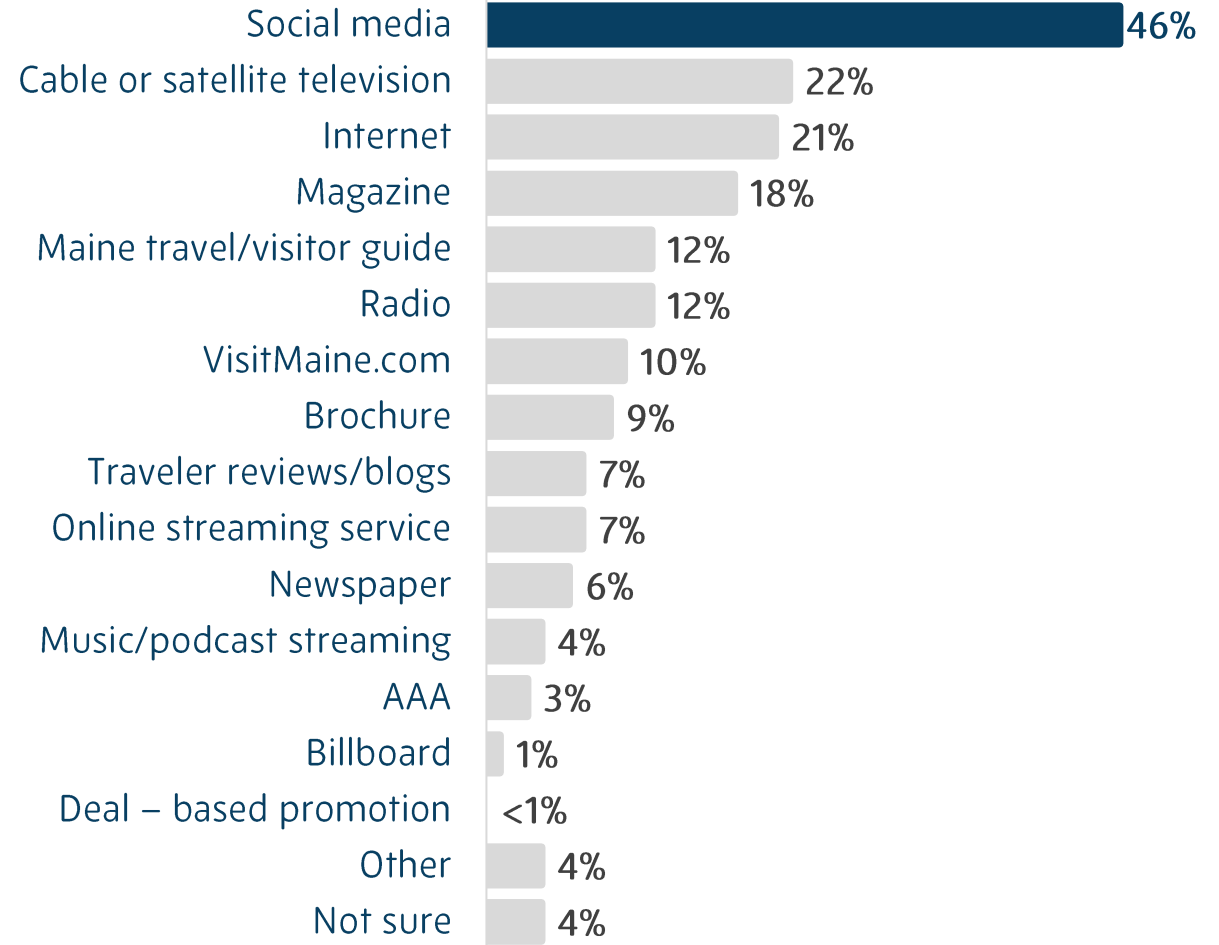
- » Nearly **3 in 5** visitors considered visiting **ONLY** Maine while planning their trips
- » Visitors continued to be more likely to consider visiting nearby U.S. states rather than visiting Canadian provinces



PRE-TRIP RECALL OF ADVERTISING*

- » Over **1 in 3** visitors noticed advertising or promotions for Maine prior to their trip
- » Visitors who recalled this advertising primarily saw it on social media or the television
- » This information influenced **20% of all** visitors to visit Maine

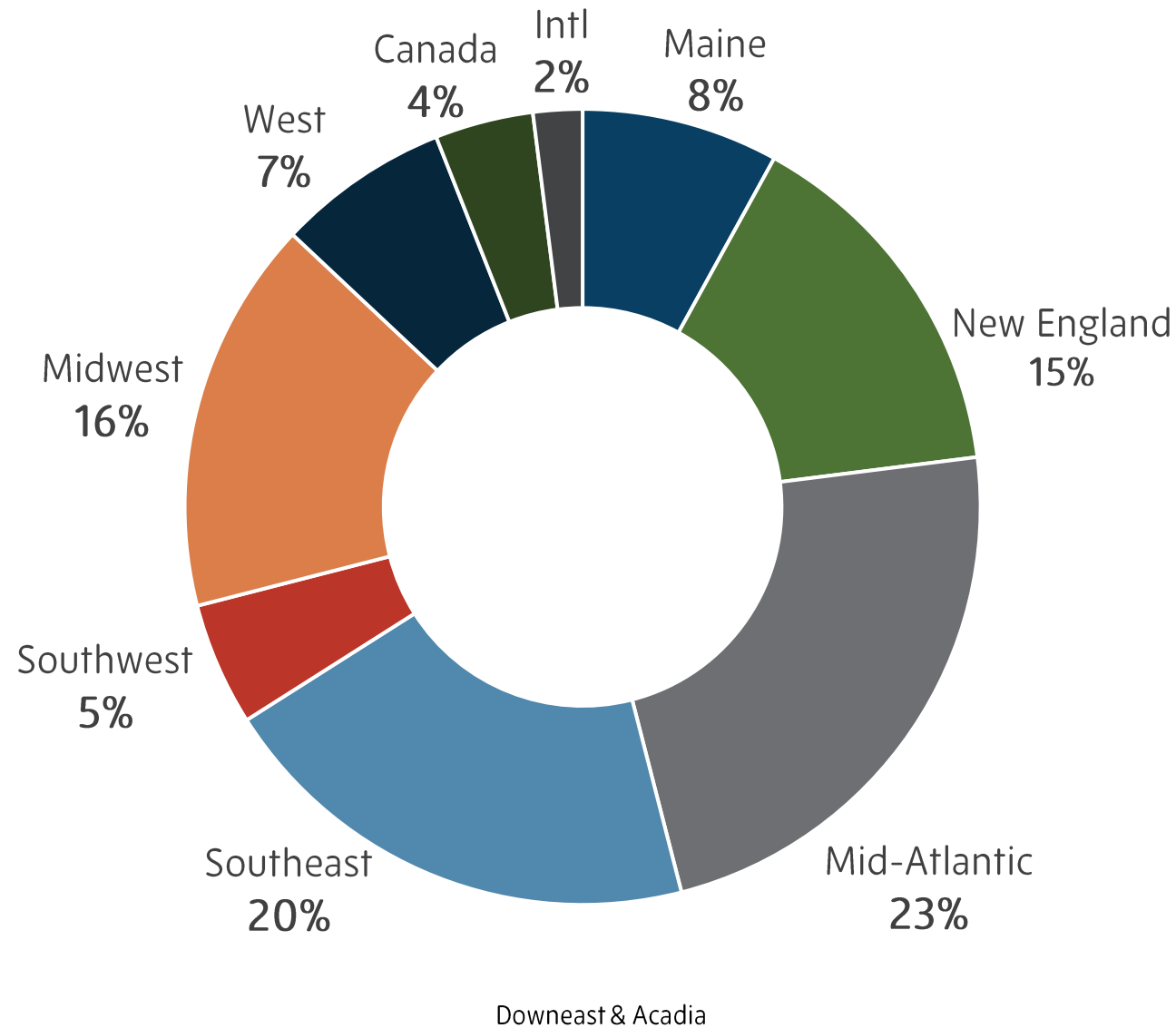

TOP ORIGIN STATES & PROVINCES

- » **57%** of visitors traveled to/within Maine from 10 U.S. states
- » **8%** of visitors were residents of Maine traveling throughout the state

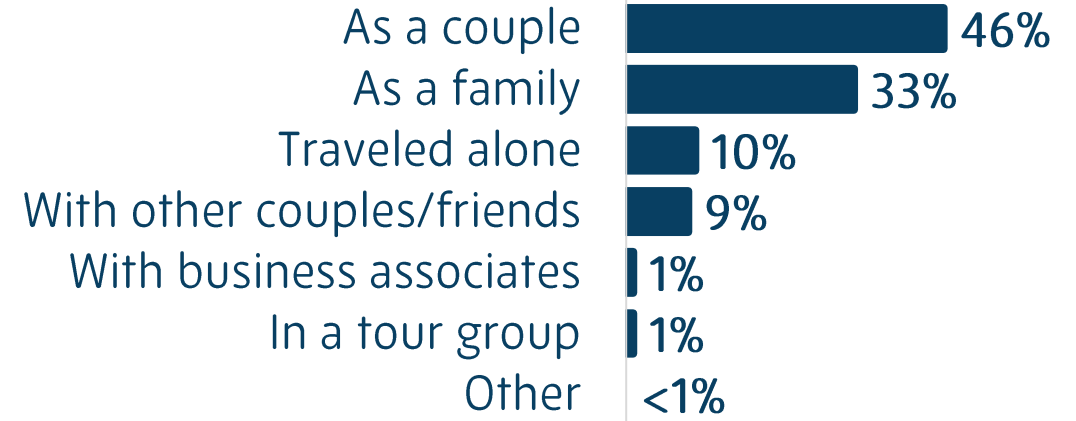

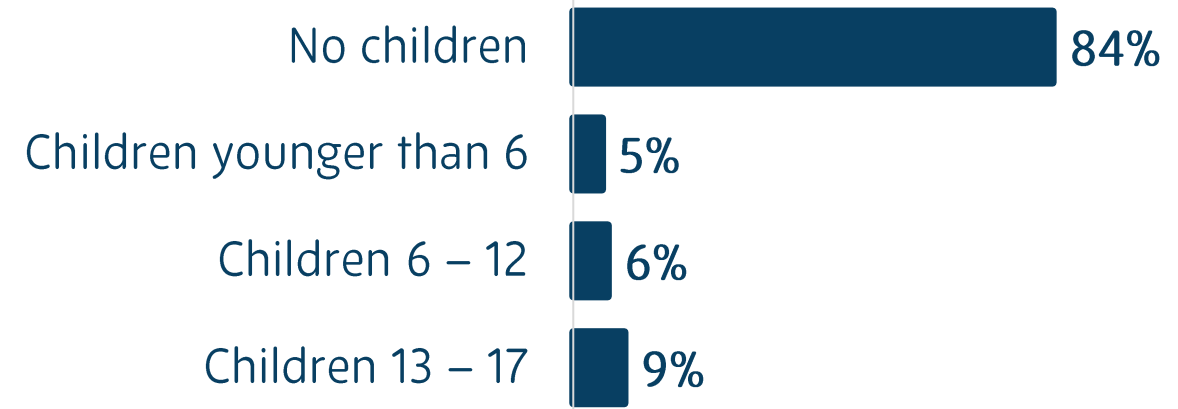
TRAVEL PARTIES

- » Typical visitors traveled to Maine in parties of **2.9** people
- » Nearly **half** of visitors traveled as a couple
- » **1 in 3** visitors traveled as a family
- » **16%** of visitors traveled with one or more children in their travel party

Travel Party Composition



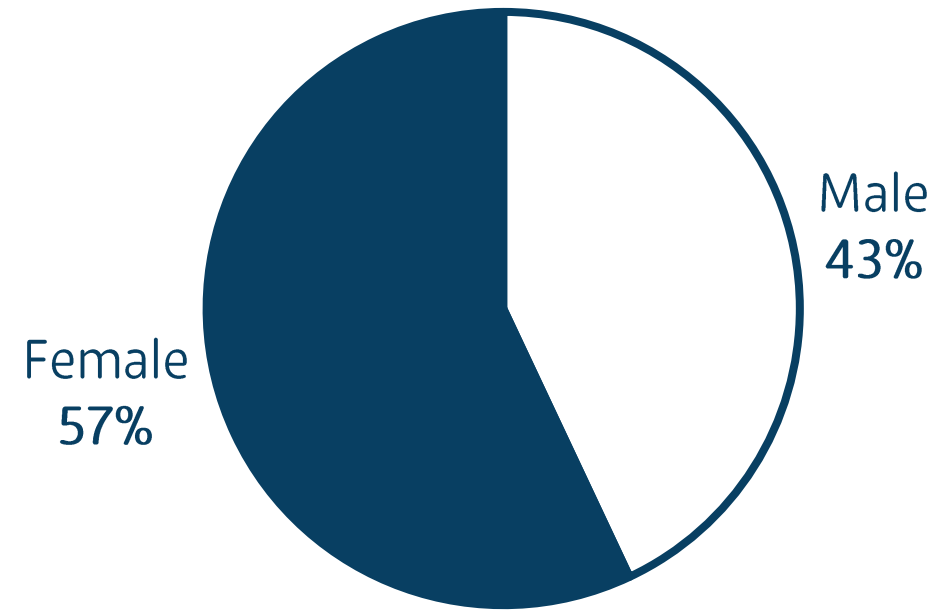
Children in Travel Party*

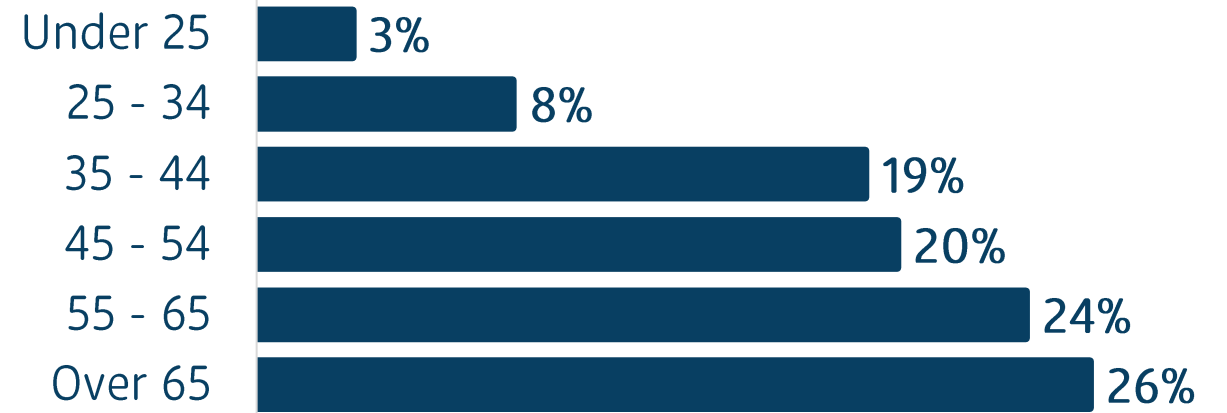
GENDER

» Nearly **3 in 5** visitors to Maine interviewed were females



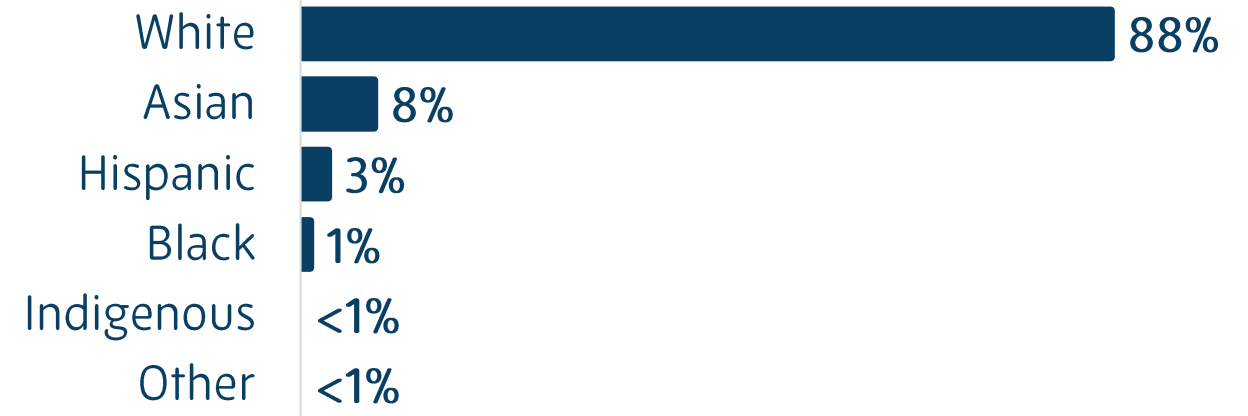
AGE

» The average age of visitors to Maine is 55 years old



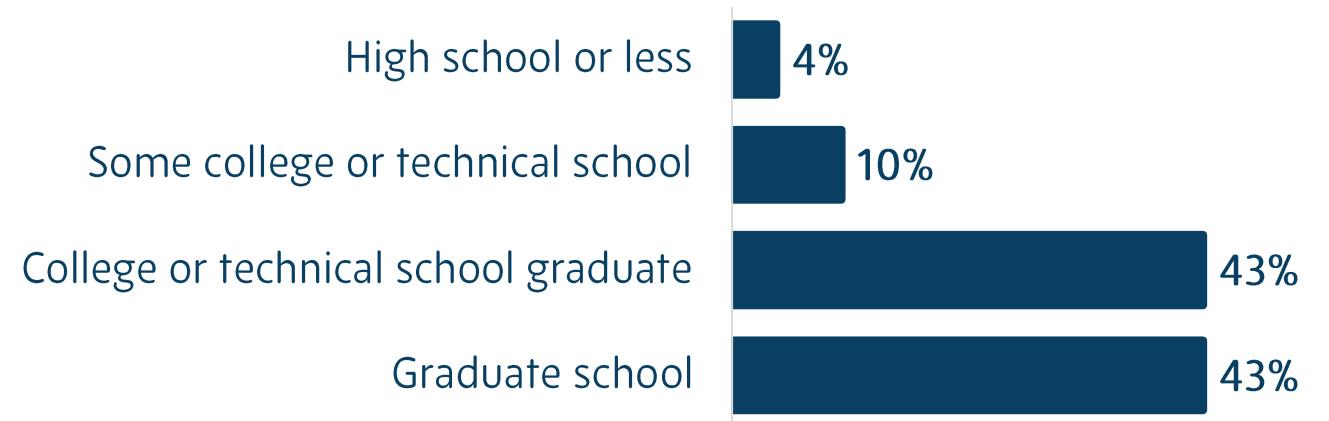
RACE & ETHNICITY

» Nearly 9 in 10 visitors to Maine were white



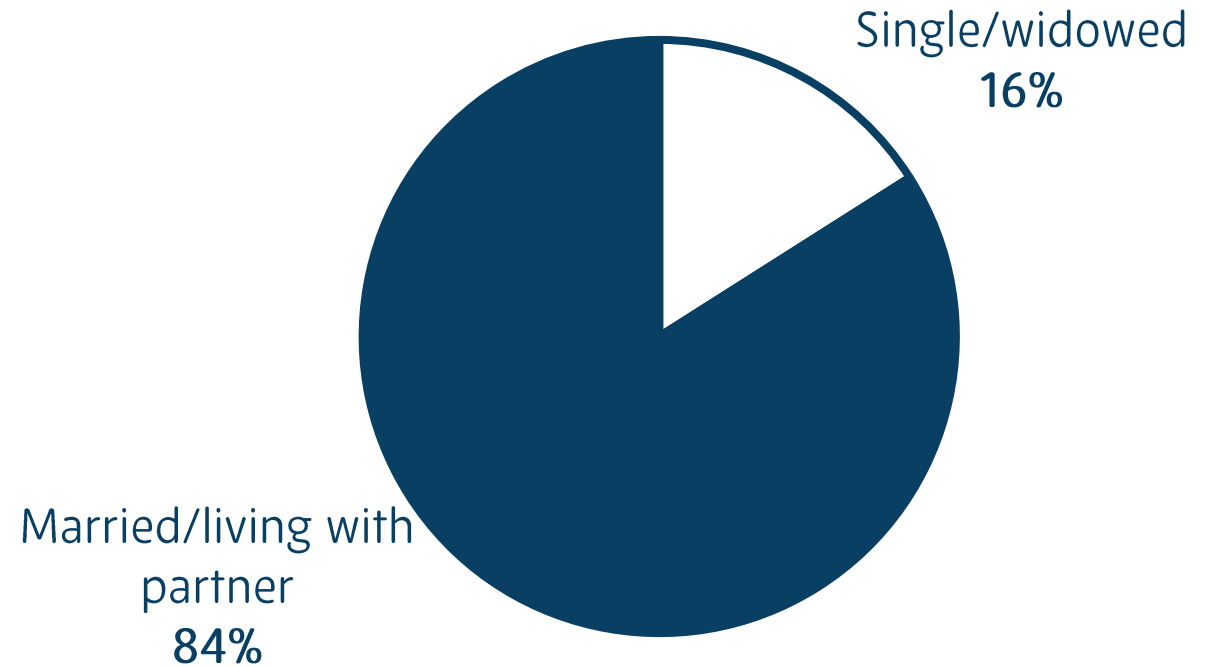
EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT

» Nearly **9 in 10** visitors have a college/technical school degree or higher



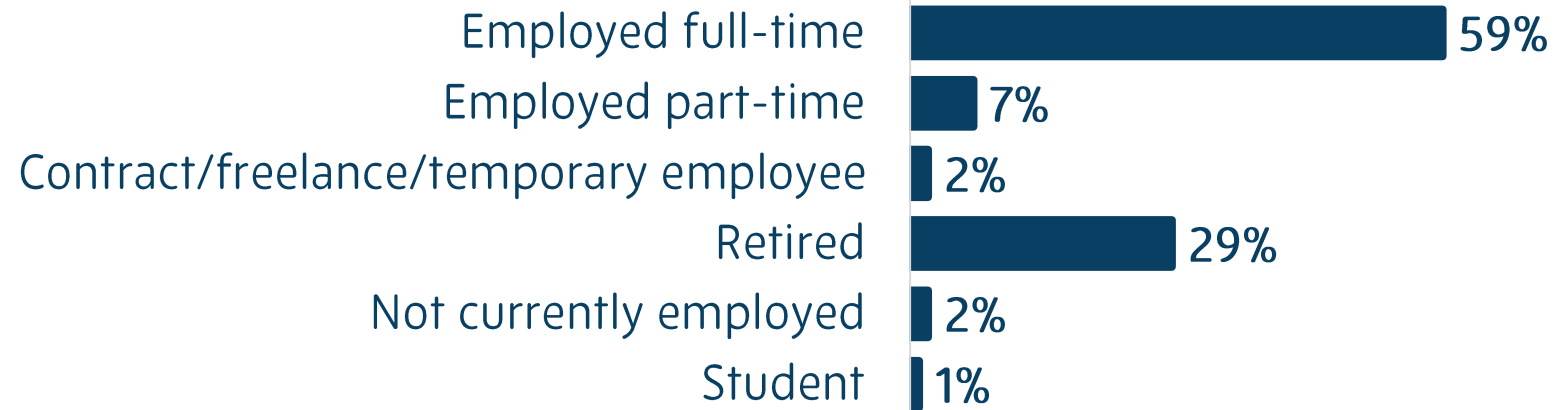
MARITAL STATUS

- » Over **4 in 5** visitors to Maine were married or living with their partner



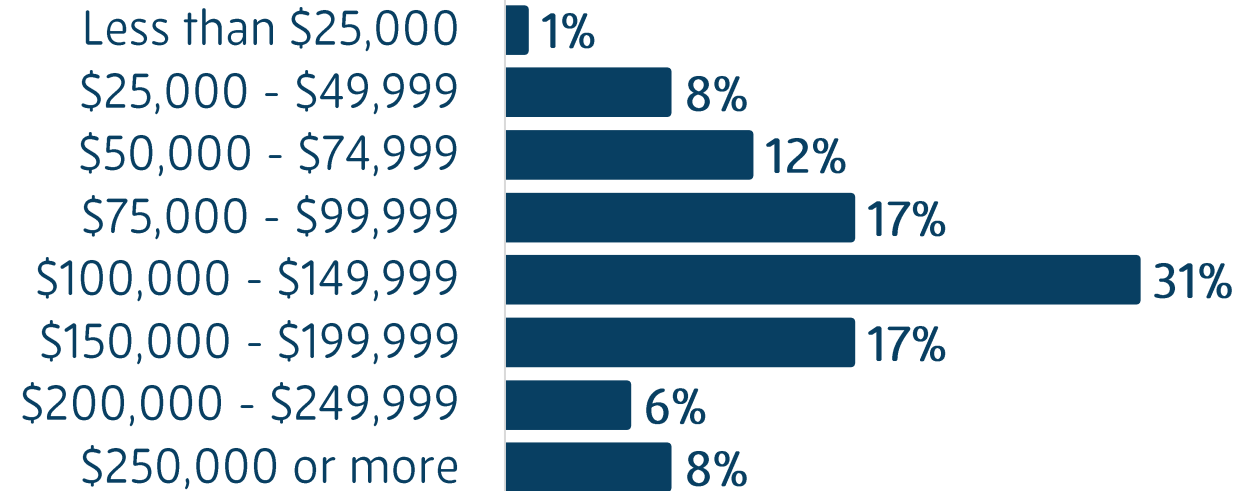
EMPLOYMENT STATUS

» Nearly **8 in 10** visitors to Maine were employed, most full-time



HOUSEHOLD INCOME

- » The average household income of visitors to Maine is **\$119,400** per year
- » **31%** of visitors to Maine earned more than \$150,000 per year



NEW & RETURNING VISITORS

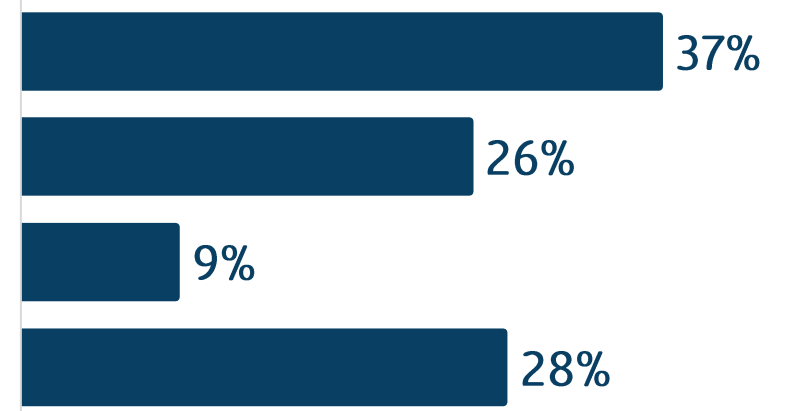
- » 37% of visitors were traveling in Maine for the first time
- » Maine has high repeat and loyal visitors, as 28% had previously traveled in Maine more than 10 times

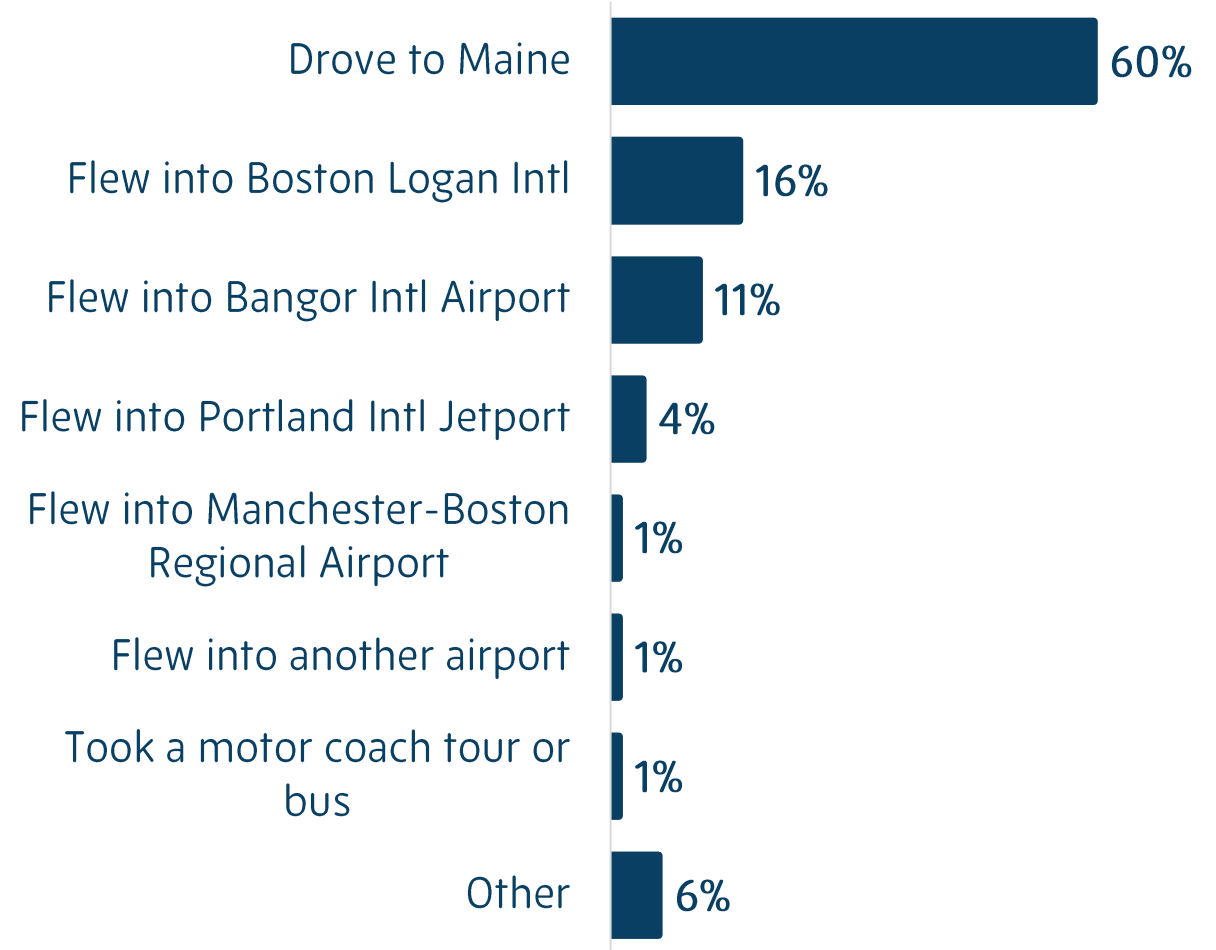

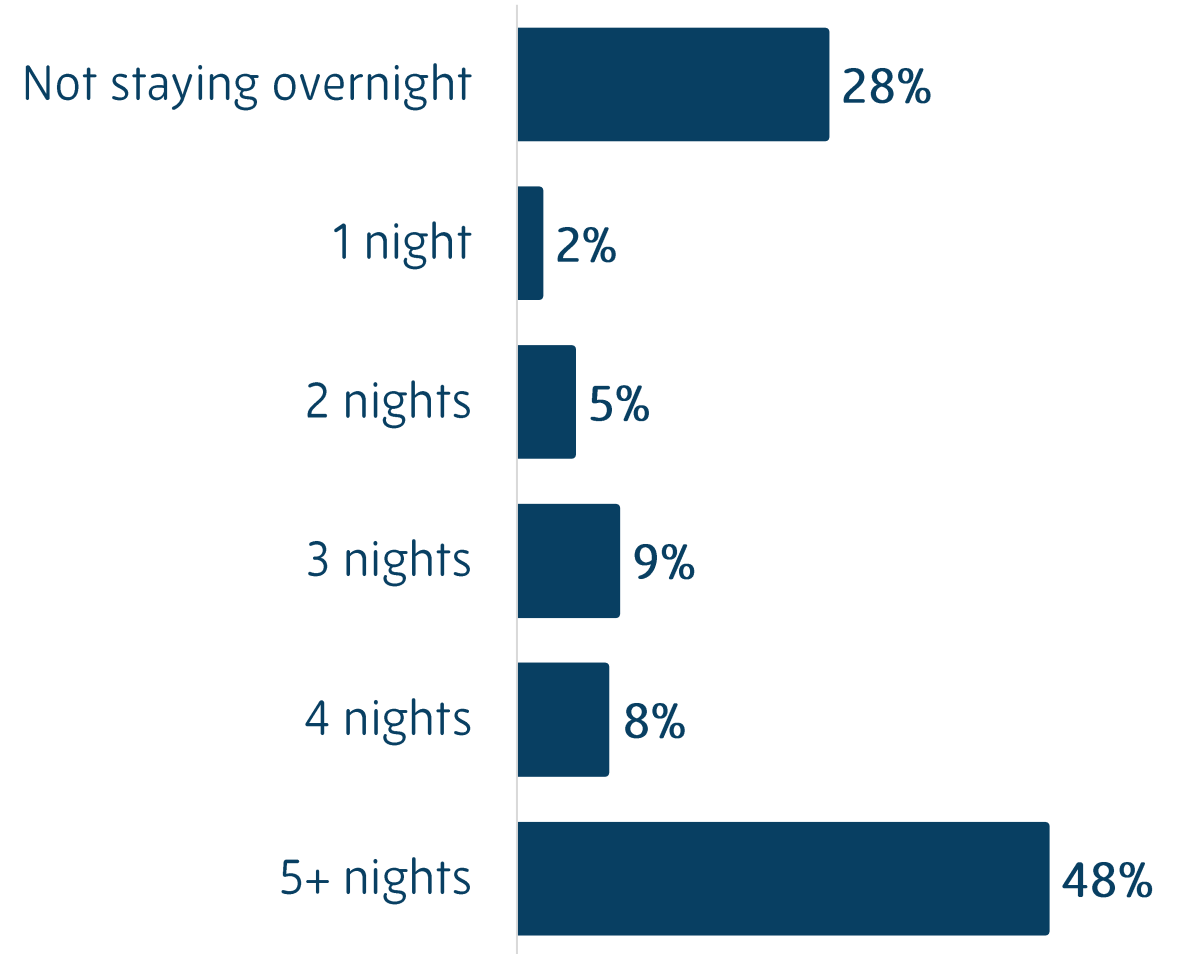
MODES OF TRANSPORTATION

- » Maine is a drive-market for most visitors, with **60%** choosing to travel by car over plane, motor coach/bus, or train
- » Most visitors who flew to Maine arrived at Boston Logan International Airport or Bangor International Jetport



NIGHTS STAYED

- » 72% of visitors stayed one or more nights in Maine on their trip
- » Typical visitors stayed 5.8* nights in Maine on their trips
- » Typical visitors staying overnight in paid accommodations stayed 5.3 nights in Maine on their trips

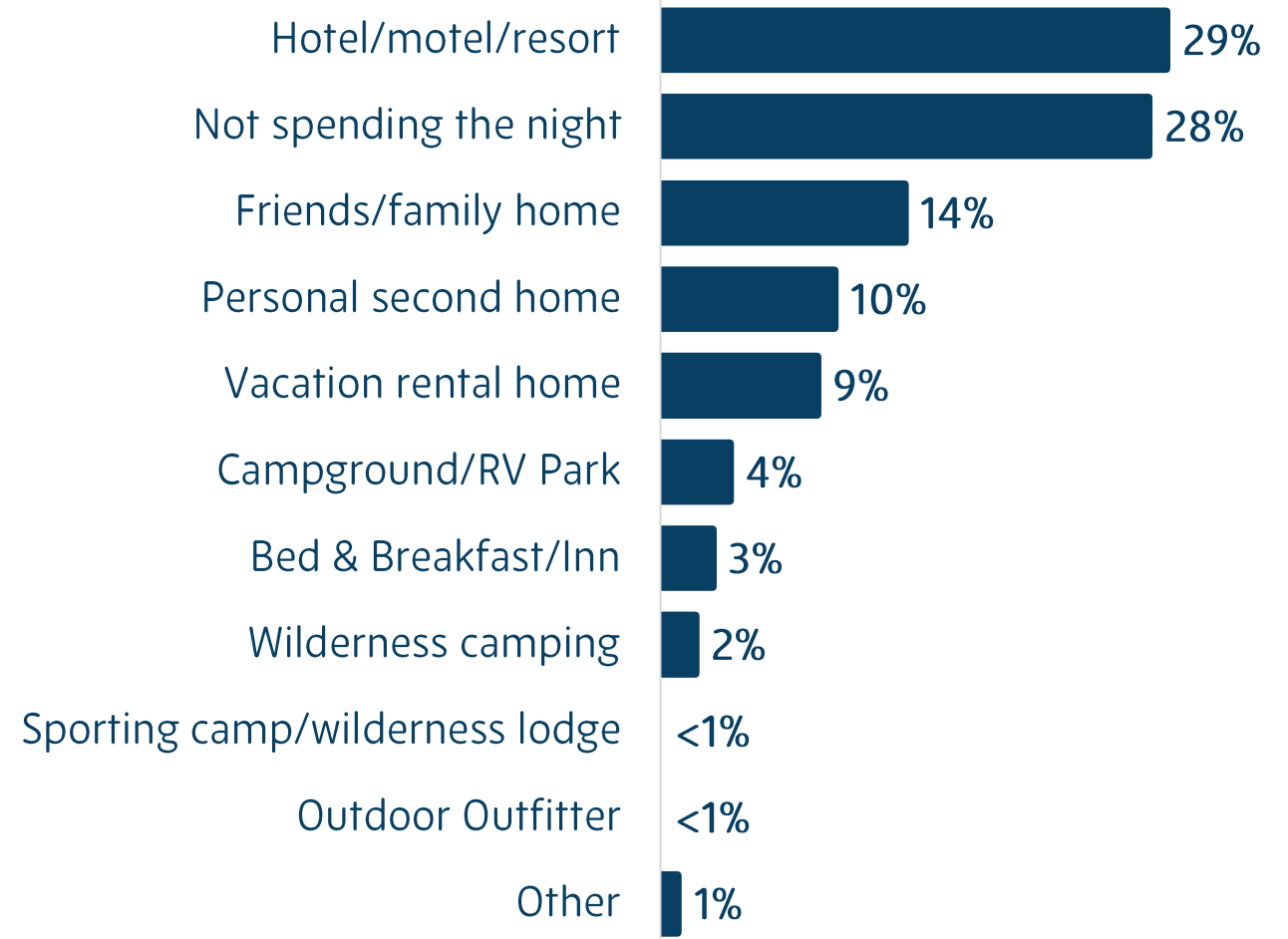

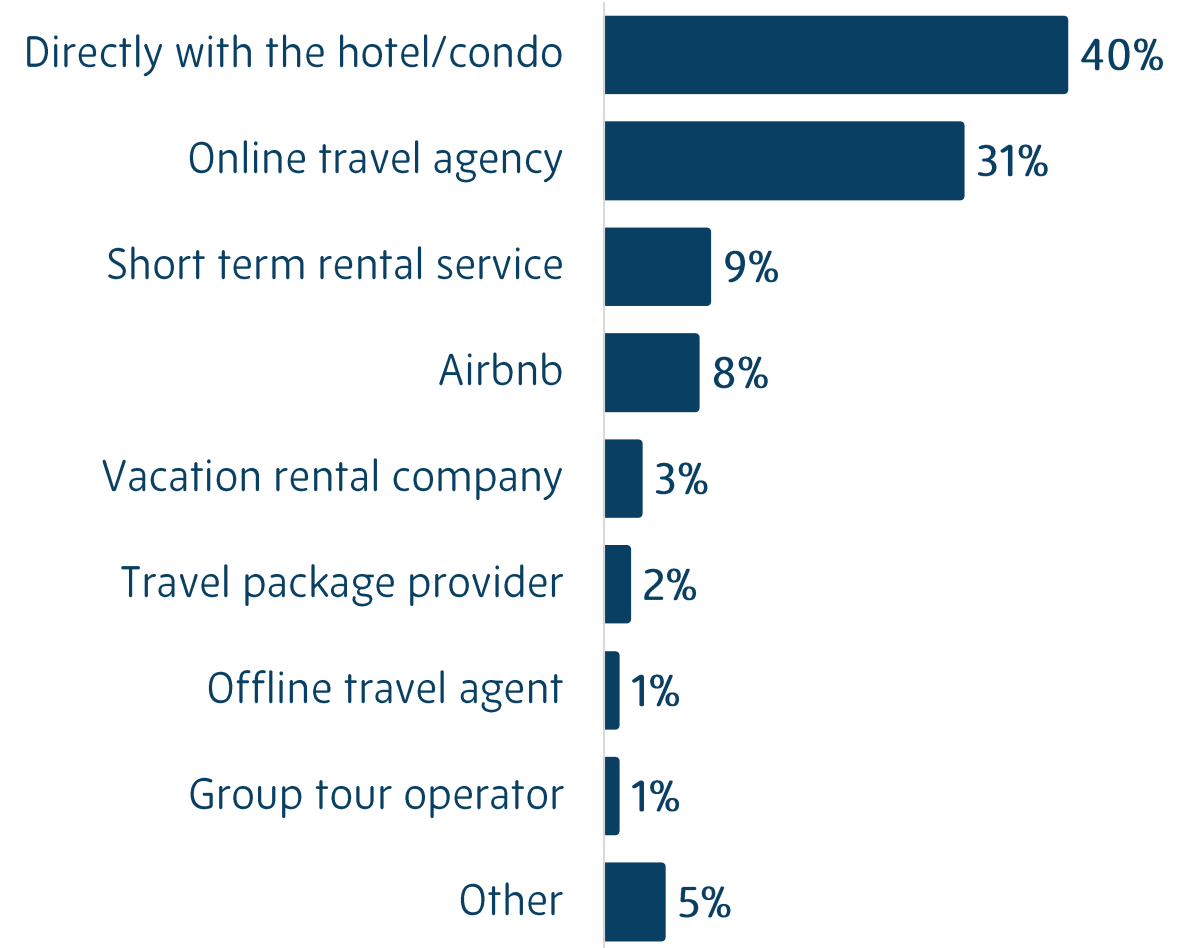
ACCOMMODATIONS

» Nearly **3 in 10** visitors stayed overnight at a hotel/motel/resort or were just visiting the area for the day



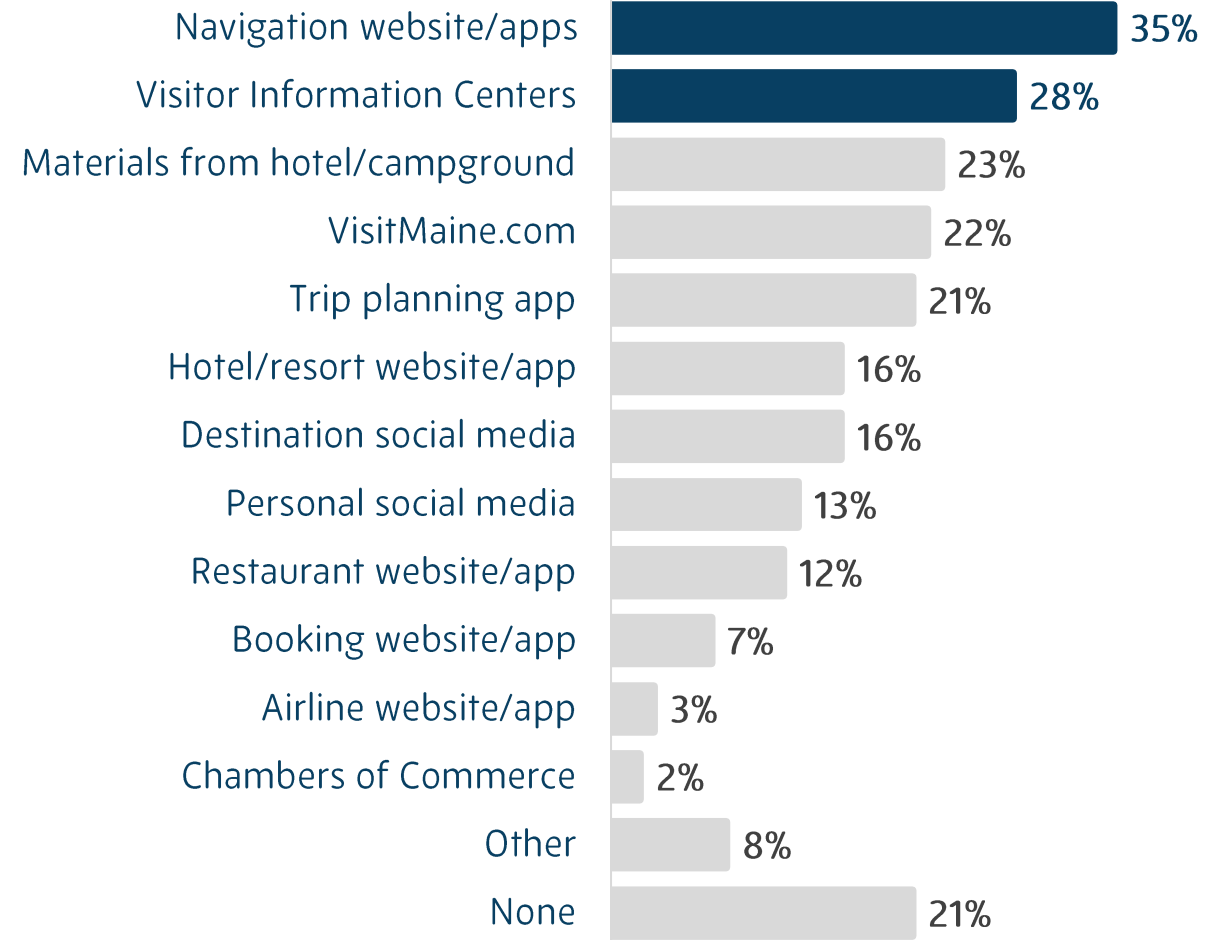
BOOKING METHODS

» **2 in 5** visitors who stayed in paid accommodations during their trip booked their lodging directly with the hotel/condo



IN-MARKET VISITOR RESOURCES*

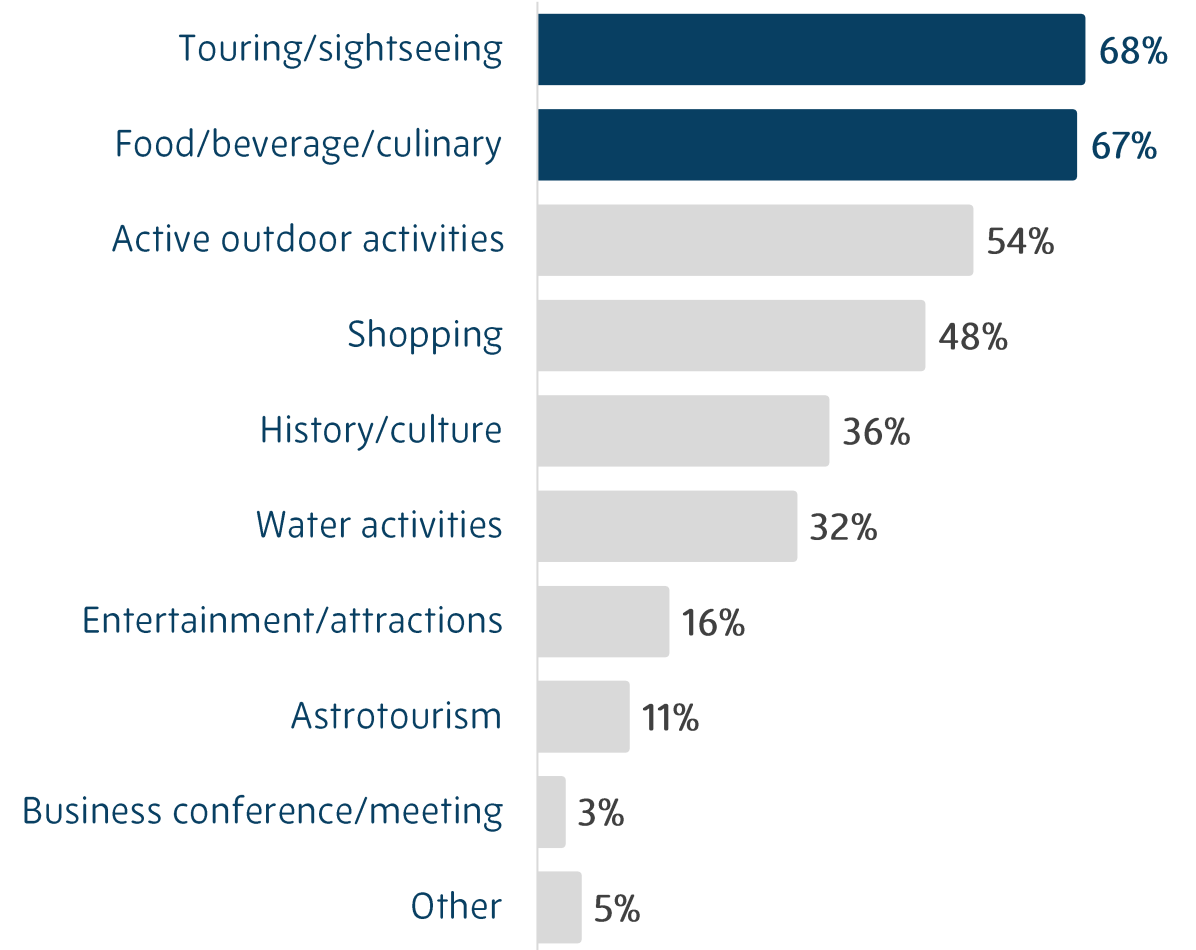
- » Visitors were more likely to rely on navigation websites/apps (i.e., Google Maps, etc.) to plan activities in-market
- » Nearly **3 in 10** visitors went to visitor information centers
- » **1 in 5** visitors did not use any resources to plan activities while they were in-market



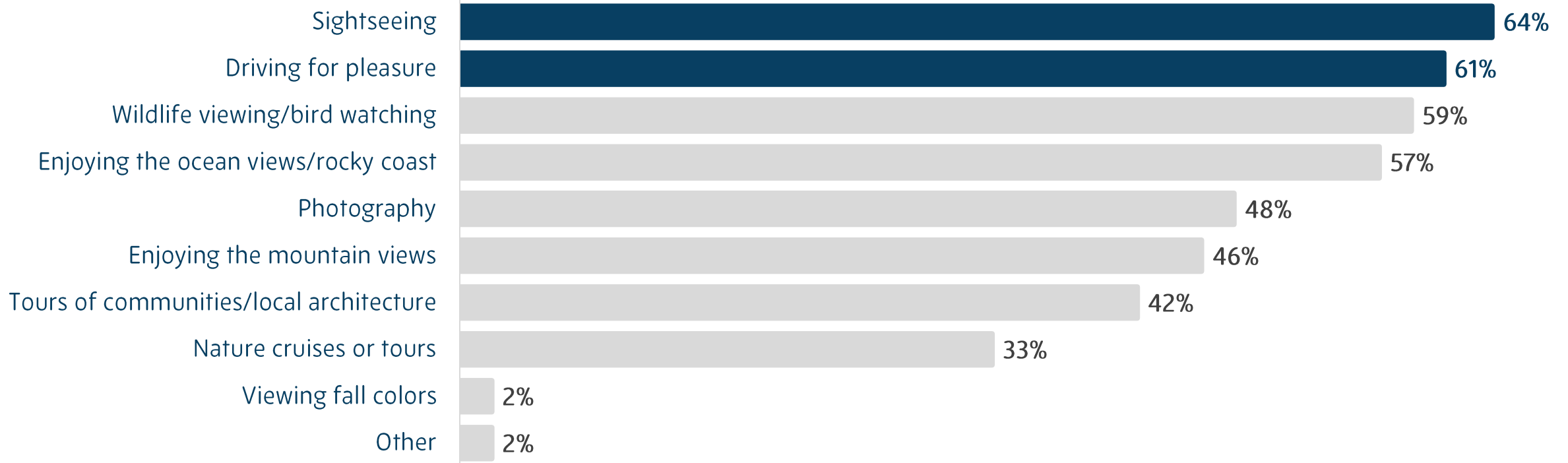

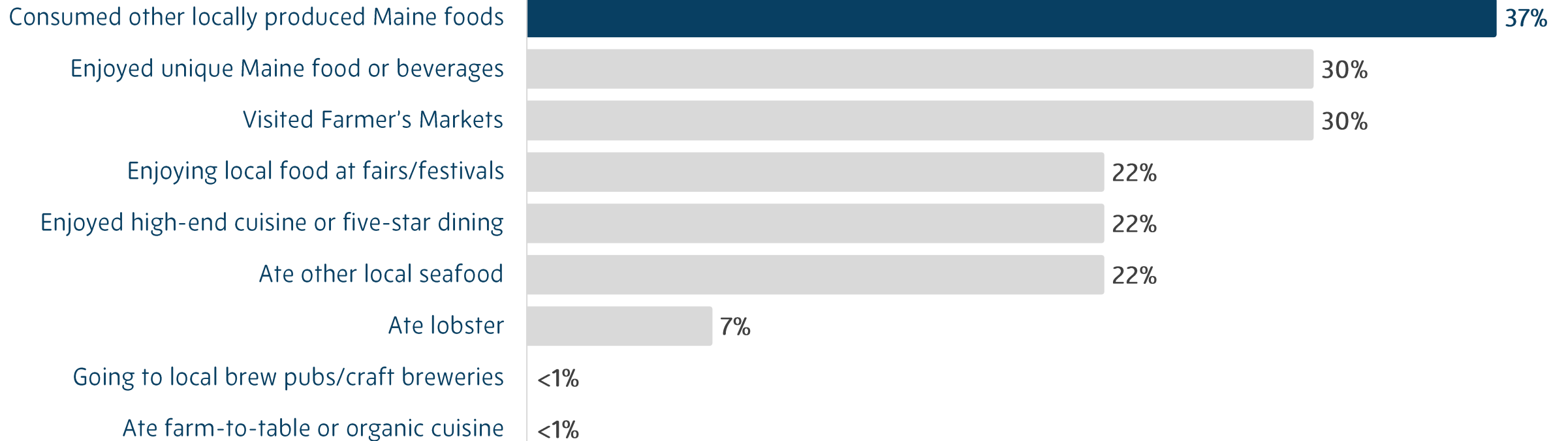
» Nearly **7 in 10** visitors went touring/sightseeing or engaged in food/beverage/culinary activities during their trip to Maine

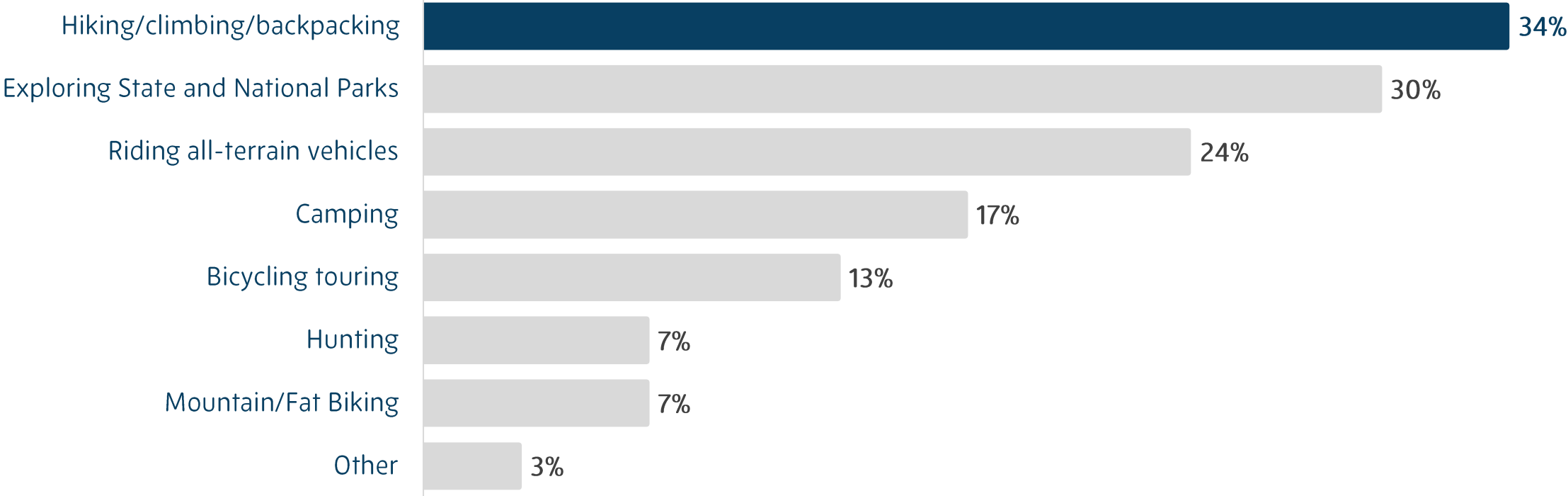

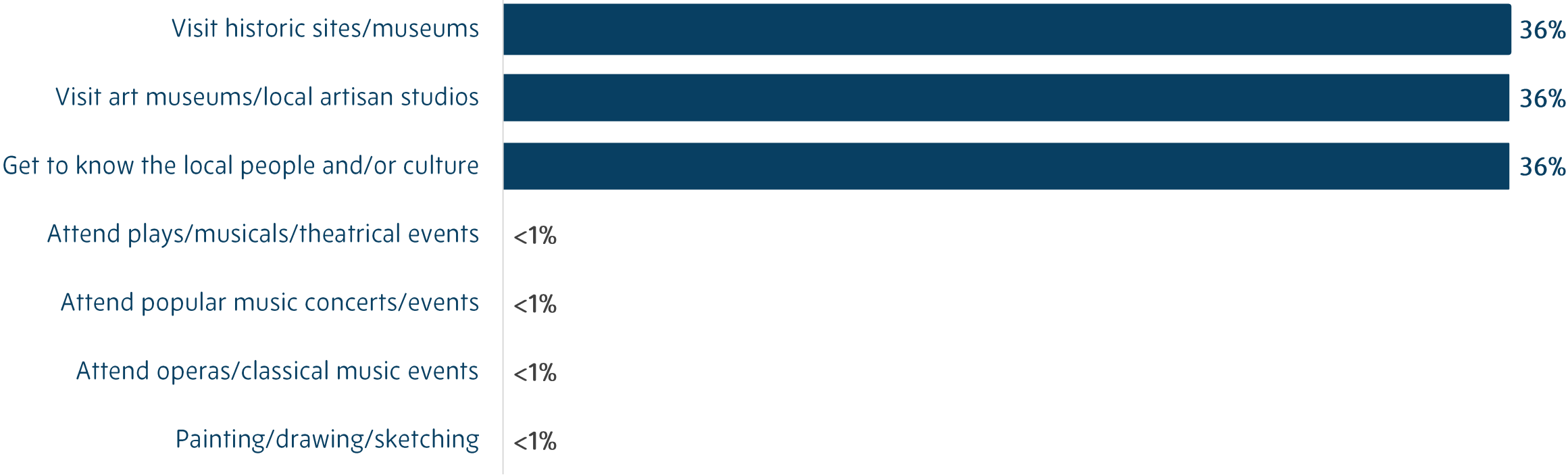

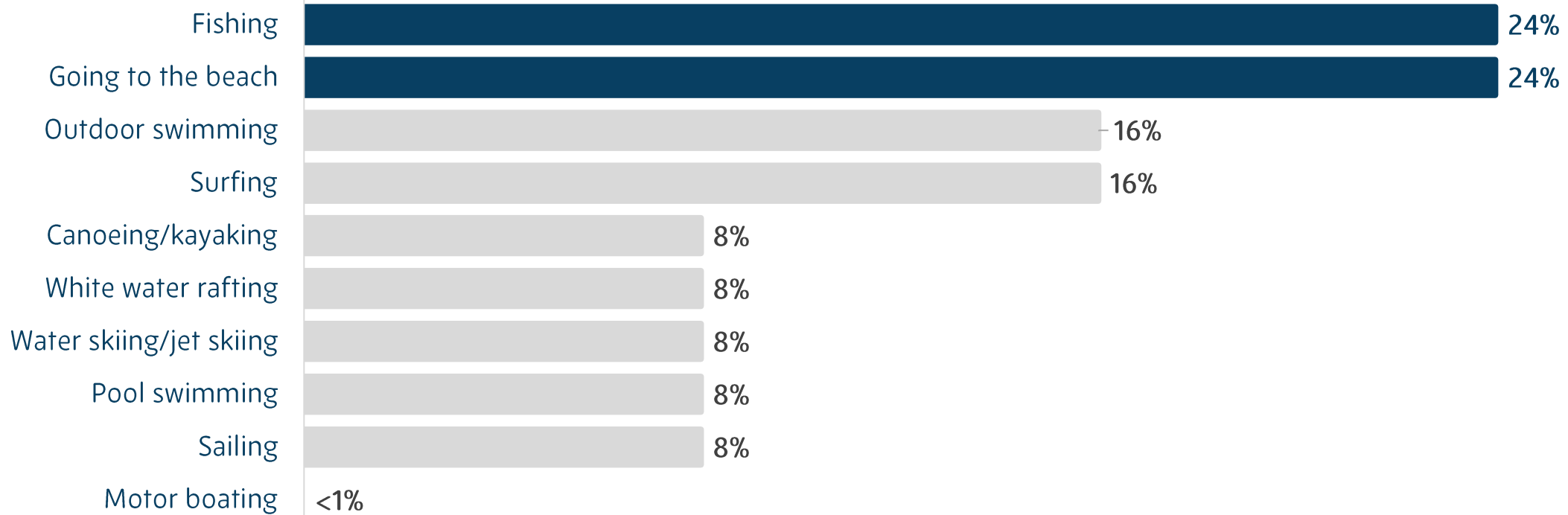

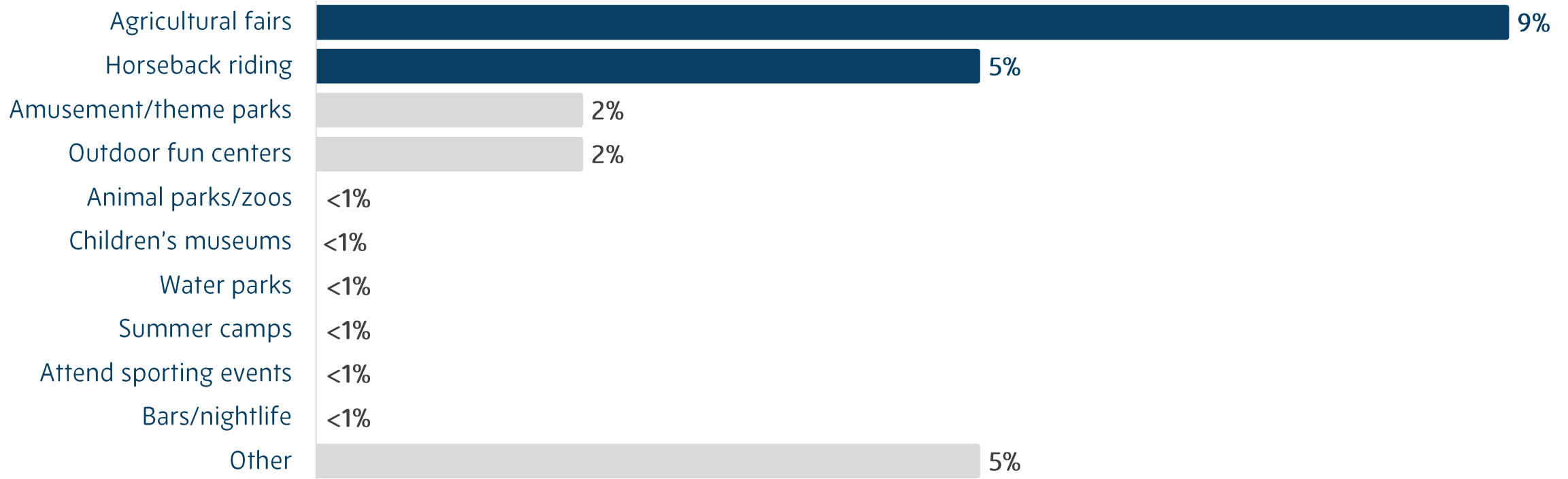

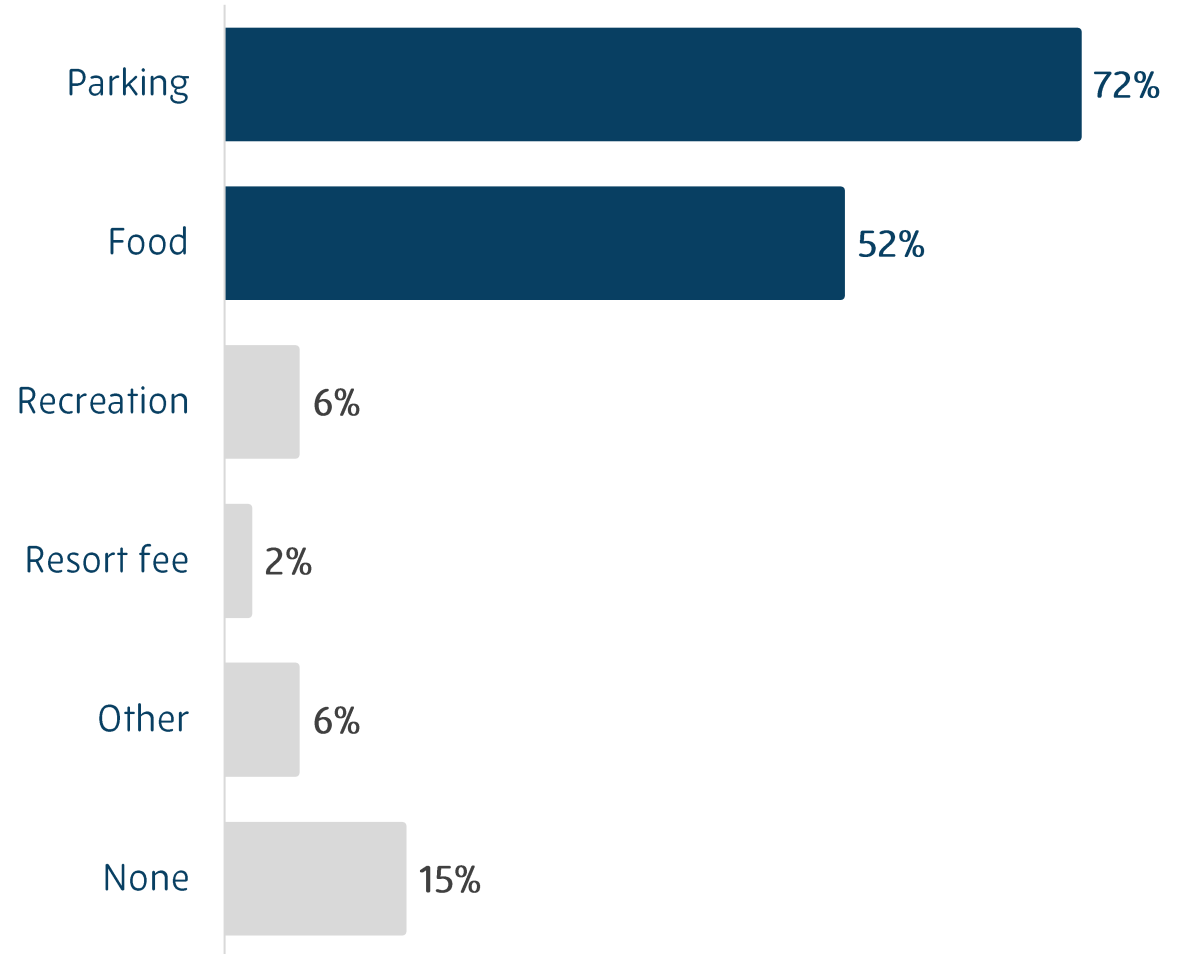

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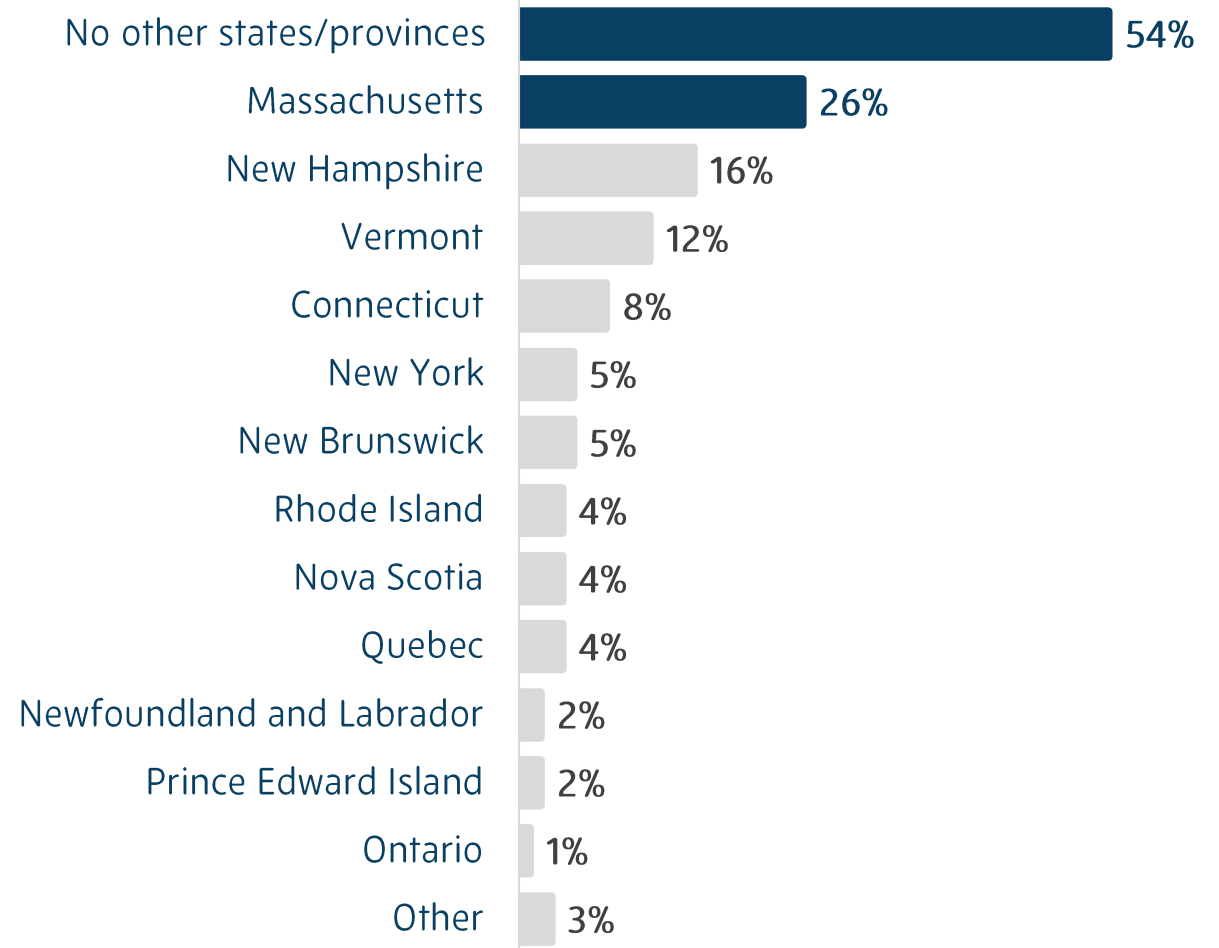
LODGING AMENITIES*

- » An amenity, e.g., food, resort fee, recreation fee, parking, etc. was included in the room price for over **4 in 5** visitors
- » Price for accommodations included parking for over **7 in 10** visitors
- » Food was included in accommodations' pricing for **52%** of visitors



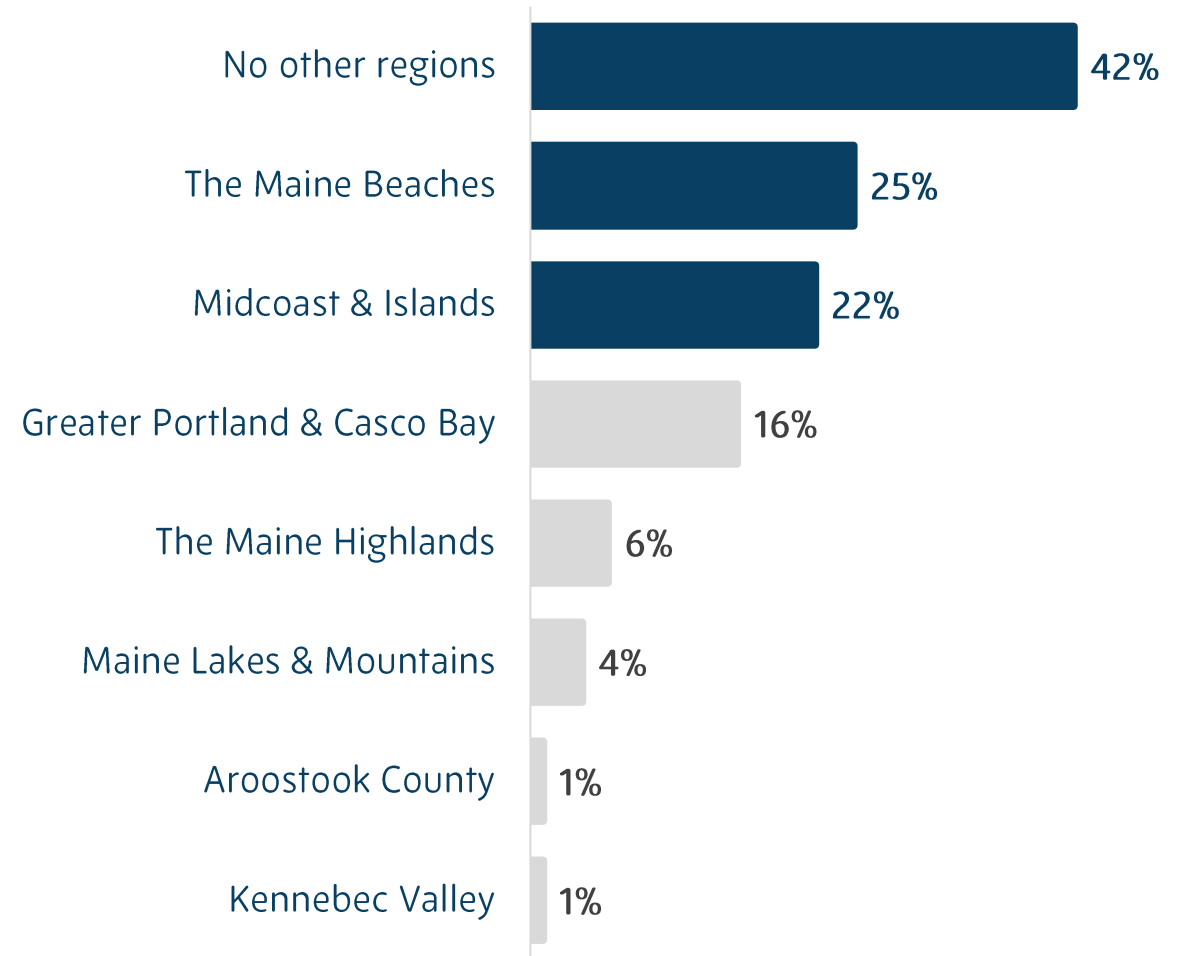
OTHER STATES & PROVINCES VISITED*

- » 54% of visitors did not visit any other U.S. state or Canadian province during their trip
- » Visitors continued to be more likely to visit U.S. states near Maine than they were to visit a Canadian province during their trip



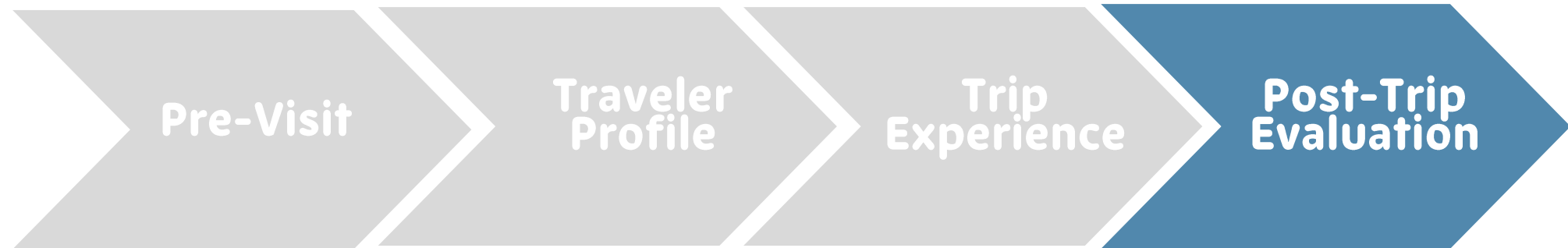
TRAVELING WITHIN MAINE*

- » Over **2 in 5** visitors stayed within the region of their primary destination during their trip in Maine, rather than traveling throughout the state
- » About **1 in 4** visitors visited the Maine Beaches and the Midcoast & Islands in addition to their primary destination within Maine

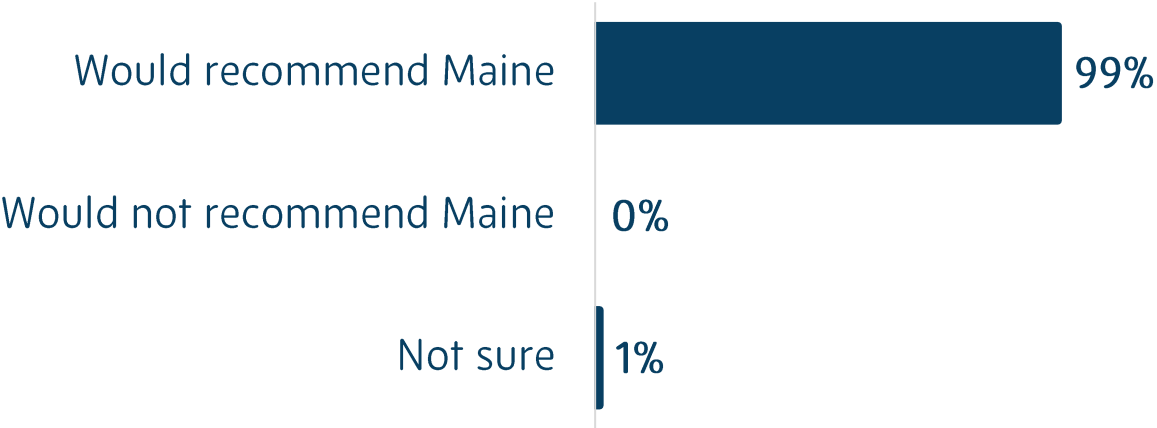

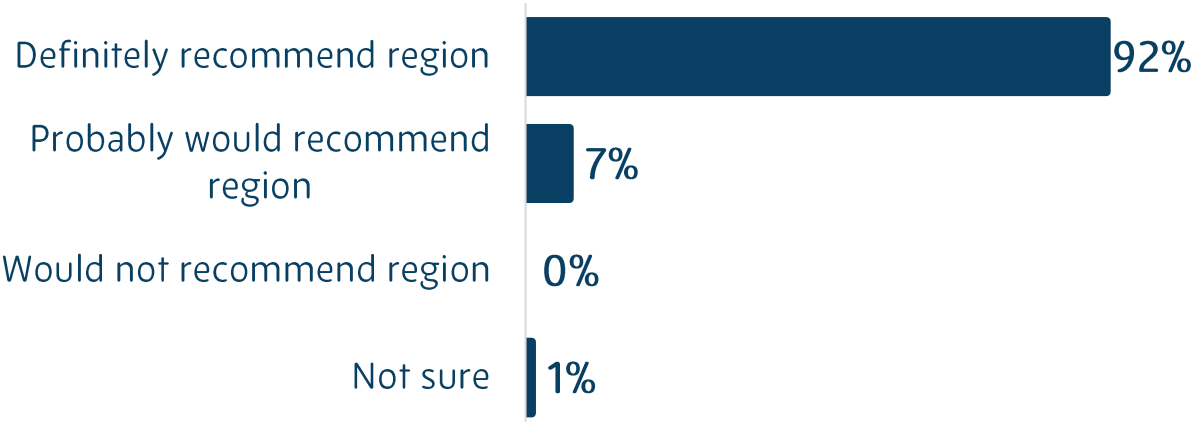
RECOMMENDING MAINE & ITS REGIONS

- » 99% of visitors would recommend that their friends and family choose Maine as their destination for a future visit or vacation
- » 99% of visitors would recommend that their friends and family visit the specific region of Maine that they traveled to on their trip – 92% would definitely recommend

LIKELIHOOD OF RETURNING TO MAINE

» **96%** of visitors will return to Maine for a future visit or vacation

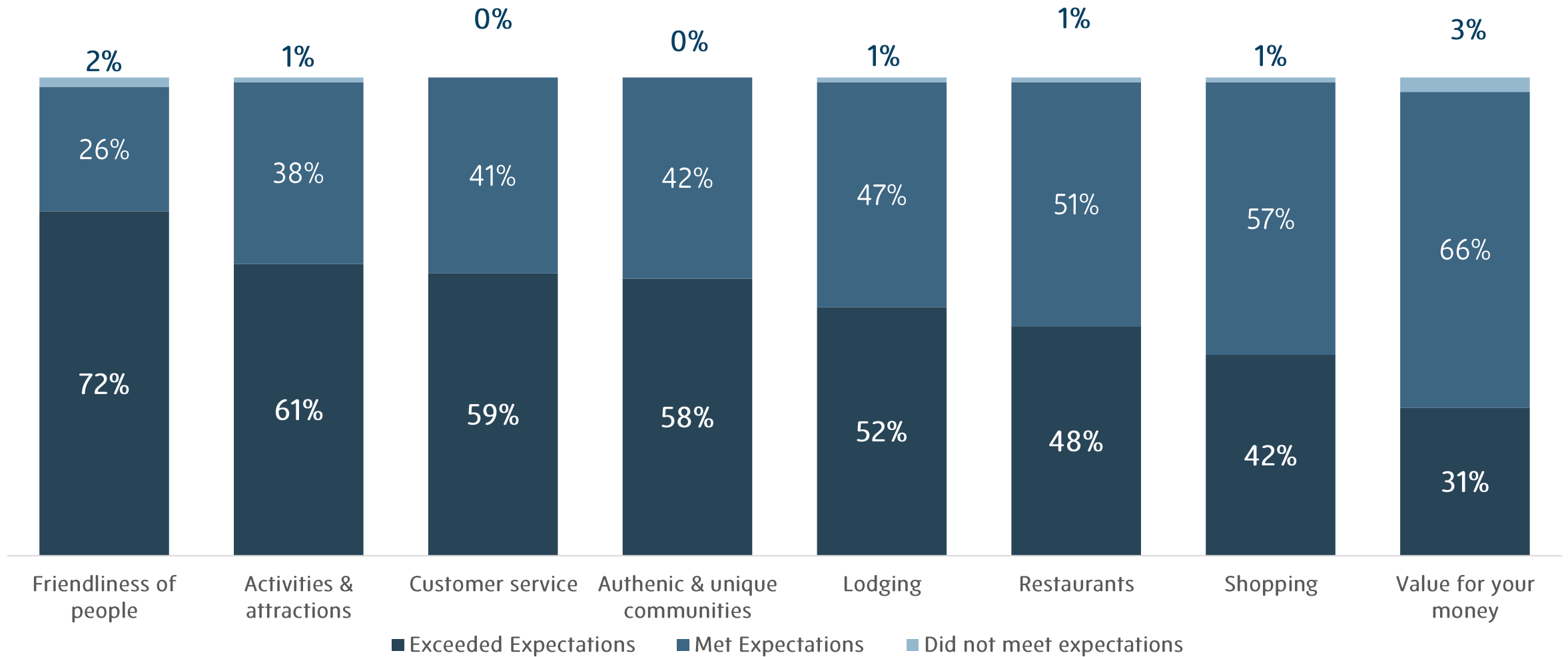

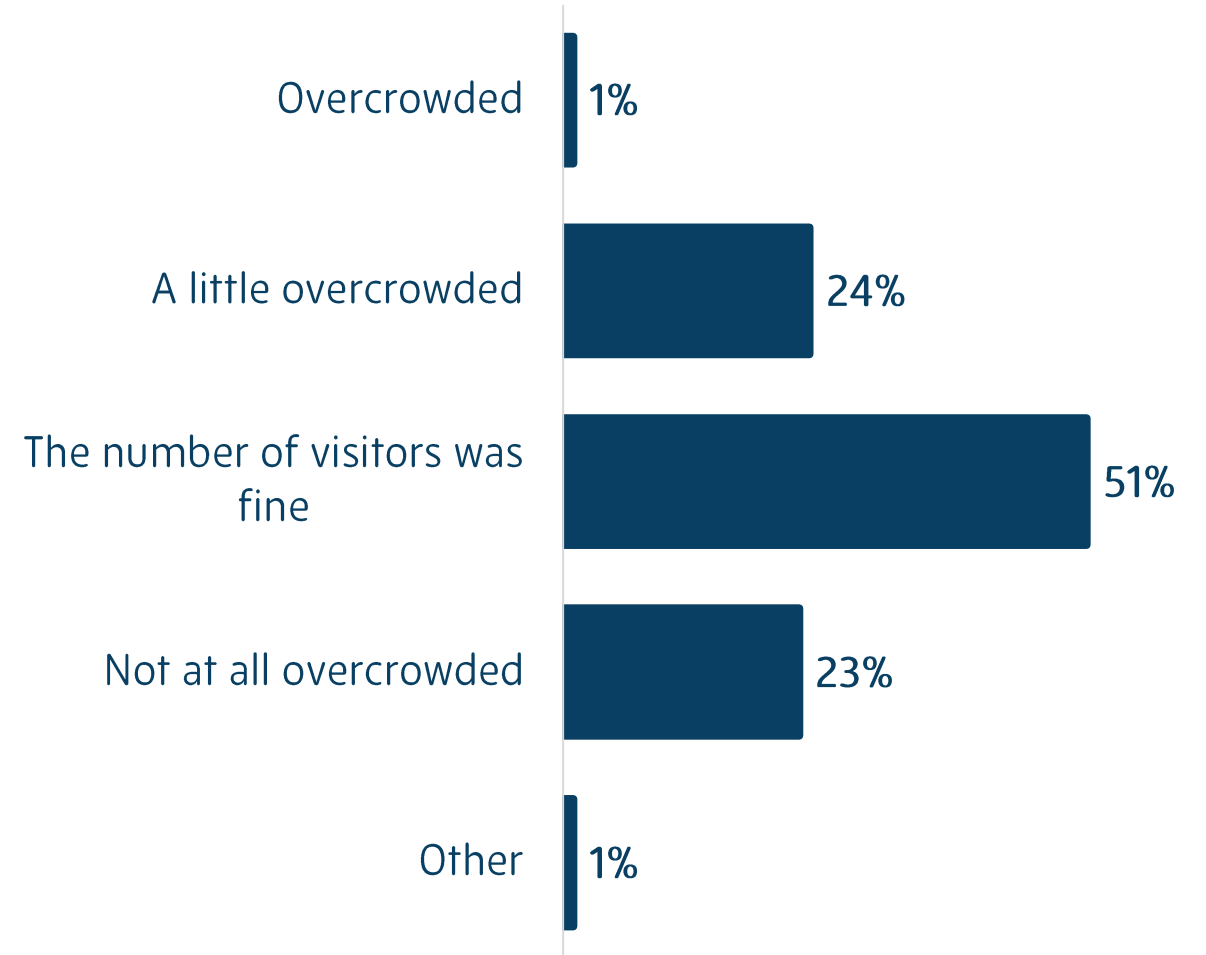
