BY THE NUMBERS

In 2023, visitors directly spent \$2,630,442,700 in the Maine Beaches, a 2.8% decrease from 2022. As one of the state's largest industries, tourism supported 34,300 jobs and contributed to \$1,424,161,900 in total wages supported in the Maine Beaches region. In 2023, visitors to the state also saved every Maine Beaches household \$4,140 in state and local taxes.

MAINE BEACHES OVERNIGHT VISITORS

Throughout 2023, the Maine Beaches saw **2,713,500** overnight visitors, generating **2,851,200** room nights in accommodations, down 2.5% from 2022.

MAINE BEACHES VISITORS

Maine Beaches hosted **1,082,600** day visitors in 2023 a 16.1% decrease from 2022.

TOTAL VISITOR DAYS

All visitors to Maine Beaches spent **14,323,700 days** in Maine Beaches throughout 2023 a 23.7% decrease from 2022.

VISITORS & JOBS

Visitors to Maine Beaches supported **34,300 jobs** throughout the region and **\$1,424,161,900** in wages in 2023. Every 111 visitors support a new job in Maine Beaches.
